The 2013 AAU Diving National Championship will be using cleanentries.com as the online registration.

- 1. To register your athlete(s) and/or team(s) please visit www.diveaau.org. Click on the Online Registration link to get started!
- 2. Please follow the instructions for cleanentries.com registration.
 - a. Click on 2013 AAU Diving National Championships.
 - b. Click on **DIVERS** (upper right hand corner of the page).
 - c. Create your account and/or Login to your account.
 - d. Once you have logged in, please select the event(s) the athlete(s) will participate in. You will need your AAU membership ID and valid zip code associated with the AAU membership in order to register for the event(s). Please ensure that the athlete's information on cleanentries.com matches the following on the AAU membership: 1) Name 2) Zip Code 3) Correct membership ID entered and 4) Date of Birth is correct. All four (4) items must match exactly in both systems.
 - i. **NOTE**: In order for divers to register and select their team, the coach MUST register on the site first and add their team to the database.
 - e. Proceed to check out.
 - i. Divers can pay their registration fee for the entire meet with one purchase by visiting the dashboard.
