GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION

CHAMPIONSHIPS VENUES

Competition will take place at the Orlando Sports Center at 6700 Kingspointe Parkway, Orlando, FL 32819.

TEAM CHECK-IN

Athletes may check-in as early as Sunday, August 12, 2018 to receive their credential and player souvenir bag. All athletes must check in each day he/she is playing.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The Championships will be conducted in a format that will determine National Champions in each age or skill division, as well as providing the maximum amount of playing time for each participant. Some division may be combine due to the number of participates. The tournament director will make this decision. The team event will be made up of a women's team and men's team and a mixed team. The format will be pool play to elimination. This could be changed depending on the number of participates.

TEAM ELIGIBILITY

This is an **OPEN** National Championship. Any team meeting the requirements is eligible to enter. No qualifying required. All athletes, coaches and clubs must be current members of the AAU.

Teams submitting false AAU registration information may be dropped from the event and entry fees may be forfeited. Other actions may be taken as approved by the Championship Committee.

The team event will be made up of a women's team and men's team and a mixed team. The format will be pool play to elimination. This could be changed depending on the number of participates.

AAU MEMBERSHIP

All athletes and non-athletes (staff personnel, coaches, chaperones, etc.) must be current AAU members. Regular youth athlete membership is \$14 and regular non-athlete and adult athlete membership is \$16. Teams must also be part of a registered AAU Club. AAU Club Membership is available in 3 levels ranging from \$30, \$60 and \$300. Please visit the web site at <u>www.aaupickleball.org</u> for descriptions of each category. There can be multiple teams under one club membership. To become an AAU member, register online at <u>www.aaupickleball.org</u>.

You can no longer register for an adult membership onsite. Background screens are conducted for all non-athletes. Membership is no longer instant. BE PREPARED and register your coaches, chaperones and administrators early! You can only add a coach or chaperone onsite with a valid AAU membership number. Applied status or pending memberships are not acceptable.

PCA COACHES' EDUCATION

The AAU is happy to continue to offer <u>FREE Coaches' Education</u> for all AAU non-athletes. This exciting program is **MANDATORY** for all AAU coaches and will be administered by Positive Coaching Alliance (PCA). Please visit <u>http://aausports.org/Partners/PositiveCoachesAlliance.aspx</u> to take the mandatory AAU/PCA coaches' education course. <u>There are THREE courses available this year</u> - Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3. Members are required to take one level per year. Level 1 is for those new to PCA training. Level 2 is for those who completed the Level 1 course last year. Level 3 is for those who completed the Level 2 course last year.

RULES OF THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Championships will be conducted under the AAU Code, AAU Pickleball Handbook, and the current playing rules of USA Pickleball, as modified by the AAU National Pickleball Committee. <u>Additional information may be made available or revised online or at Team</u> <u>Check-In.</u>

Key Rules of Play:

• AAU membership guidelines will be followed.

Ball:

• The ball used for the 2018 AAU National Indoor Pickleball Championships will be the ONIX.

INTERNATIONAL MEMBERS

International athletes must be AAU members (\$14 per youth athlete and \$35 per adult athlete).

SPECTATOR TICKETS

Daily spectator tickets will be available for \$5 for adults and children. Length of event tickets will be available for \$30 for adults and children.
