Biography:

David Boudia was honored as USA Diving's Athlete of the Year in 2012, earning the award for the fourth time in his career. The two-time Olympian won gold in the men's 10-meter platform event at the 2012 Olympic Games. In winning Olympic diving gold, Boudia became the first American man to do so since 1992 and the first American man to do so on platform since Greg Louganis in 1988. Boudia also won an Olympic bronze medal in the synchronized 10-meter event with partner Nick McCrory (Chapel Hill, N.C.), earning USA its first ever men's synchronized platform Olympic medal and becoming the first American men to win an Olympic medal since 1996. During the 2012 FINA World Series, Boudia finished second in the overall standings both individually and in synchronized diving with McCrory. He won five medals – three individually and two synchronized – over the course of the Series.
