Biography:

It doesn't get much better than the year Maggie Steffens compiled in 2012. A year removed from high school the 19 year old made her first Olympic Team after guiding Team USA to gold at the FINA World League Super Final. She followed that up with a performance at the 2012 Olympic Games that will go down in history. Steffens tied an Olympic record with seven goals in her first game, a win over Hungary. She would go on to score a record 21 goals at the Olympics en route to the Gold Medal. In the final match, Steffens scored five goals as Team USA topped Spain 8-5. For her efforts she was named Most Valuable Player of the 2012 Olympic Games. She capped off the year being named top female water polo player of 2012 by FINA, the international governing body for aquatics. In 2013 Steffens is currently competing as a freshman for the Stanford University Cardinal, reigning NCAA Champions.
