ON-LINE REGISTRATION TEAMS & UNATTACHED ATHLETES: All teams and unattached athletes must utilize www.coacho.com online entry process go to Coach O Calendar and follow the district qualifying meet links. This will permit a very efficient registration process that is easy to use. Athletes and Teams will have until 11:59 pm CST, Wednesday, June 12 to complete their registration. Please note that you must pay for your entries with a credit card online or your entries will not be accepted. Immediately after registering online, team will receive a receipt from the website, which will produce a list of all athletes for the meet. This receipt should be used as your transcript of your meet entries. If your athletes do not appear on the information, they are not registered for the meet. Please take care of these issues prior to arriving at the meet, if at all possible. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED DAY OF COMPETITION, WITH NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

FACILITIES: Track has eight lanes and runways are all weather surfaces, Only 1/4" spikes or less or flats required. Shot and Discus Areas are Concrete and will require Flats. Restrooms, Parking and Food will be available at the Track.

ADVANCEMENT: The in each group the top 16 finishers in running events and 5 in field events and 4 Relay Teams in each age group in the District Championship Meet, advance to the Area 13 National Qualifier T&F Championship in Rockford, IL., June 26th thru 29th. Athlete must participate in there own District Meet to advance with no exception unless that event is not at the District Meet. Running times, Jumping and Throws could determine on setting for the Area 13 Meet.

ELIGIBILITY: This meet is open to any athlete that falls within the age division listed below. Athletes aged 13 thru 18 may enter in up to a maximum of 4 events including relays. Younger age brackets 8 & under thru 12 may only enter in 3 events including relays. *If an athlete is entered into too many events, meet management reserves the right to reject the athlete from one or more events without notification.*

TIME/DATE: **Before coming please check time zone** – Starting time both days 8:00 am. Track will open at 7:00 am Saturday June 14th, 8 & under thru 12 year olds and Sunday June 15th, 13 thru 18 year olds.

AGE DIVISION: **Year of birth shall determine the age division in which she/he will compete in.**

Wednesday June 26 thru Sunday June 29, 2014. From there top (8) place running events, top (5) in field events, top (4) relays and four (4) multi-events go to the AAU Junior Olympic Games at Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa, July 26th thru August 2nd, 2014

Age Division Participation

The Youth Athletics Program is Comprised of nine divisions. The athletes year of birth shall determine the age division that he/she will compete in.

**** RELAYS: All Relays are still conducted in combined age divisions: 8 & after, 9 & 10, 11 & 12, 13 & 14, 15 & 16, 17 & 18. - All members of a Relay Team must have same uniforms, MANATORY: TOPS & BOTTOMS SAME IN COLOR WITH NO EXCEPTION CAUSE YOUR RELAY TEAM COULD BE DISQUALIFIED AT THE FIRST LEVEL OF COMPETETION.**

* Athletes who are still eighteen (18) years of age through the final day of any AAU National Track & Field, Multi-Events or Cross Country Championship Meet shall be eligible to compete in Young Men's or Young Women's division. Athletes must compete only in their own age division. No one may compete in a younger or older age division as a individual, expect Relays (see above rule**)
