#### **Online Entry**

Registration will only be accepted online at <u>www.coacho.com</u>. Only Visa, Master Card, Discover and American Express will be accepted. <u>No refunds for entry fees will be granted</u> <u>after entry is submitted.</u>

All athletes and coaches must have a 2016 AAU membership before registering online. For membership information or to purchase membership, go to <u>www.aausports.org</u>.

Once online meet entry has been accepted, no changes can be made. Upon completion of the online process, including the payment of entry fee, athlete entries are locked and a confirmation email is sent showing all athletes and events entered. Athletes can be added until the online meet entry is closed, but the entry and roster record of locked athletes cannot be changed.

#### **Entry Deadline**

Online entry must be submitted no later than Wednesday, June 29,, 2016, 11:59 PM Pacific Standard Time. It is the responsibility of the coach, designated administrator, athlete or parent to make sure all athletes are registered online.

#### Awards

All events are finals. The top eight (8) place finishers in each age group/division/event will be presented with a medal. Medals can be picked up at the awards tent approximately 20 minutes after the conclusion of the event.

#### **Important Information**

This is <u>NOT a qualifying meet to the AAU National Junior Olympic Games</u>. This is opportunity for the 8 and under age group to compete against other kids their same age. *Example: A 5 year old does not have to compete against an 8 year olds, only 5 year olds.* 

Athletes in this age group may compete in **<u>BOTH</u>** the AAU West Coast National Primary Championships Meet and the AAU West Coast Track & Field National Championships.
