- ALL RUNNING EVENTS REPORT TO THE "CLERK OF COURSE"

- NO ONE ALLOWED ON THE INFIELD FOR ANY REASON.
- 3-TURN STAGGER FOR ALL 4X400M RELAYS
- NO CELL PHONES, ELECTRONIC DEVICES ALLOWED BY ATHLETES IN COMPETITION AREA
- NO GLASS CONTAINERS, WATER GUNS, ALCOHOL, OR SMOKING PERMITTED ON SCHOOL PROPERTY.
- NO SPITTING OF SUNFLOWERS SEED ON SCHOOLS TRACK, STADIUM, AND BLEACHERS
- NO ATHLETE, COACH, OR PERSONS, ALLOWED IN ANY BUILDING, ROOMS, COURTYARDS OR ON ANY EQUIPMENT MAINTAIN BY EVENT OPERATOR, VENDOR(S) AND/OR UNIVERSITY.

UNATTACHED ATHLETE WILL BE ISSUED ONE (1) BAND ATHLETE AND ONE BAND (1) COACH.

PLEASE NOTE THAT WHILE AN ATHLETE CAN DECLARE ALL EVENTS WITH MARK ACHIEVED AT THE DISTRICT QUALIFIER, THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER EVENTS THAT WERE NOT COMPETED AT A DISTRICT QUALIFIER, WITH A NO MARK AT THE NATIONAL QUALIFIER.

ATHLETES WHO DID NOT COMPETE IN A DISTRICT QUALIFYING MEET WILL ONLY BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THE AAU REGION 2 NATIONAL QUALIFIER MEET IN THE, 2000M STEEPLECHASE, MULTI-EVENTS. OPEN AND MASTERS WILL BE CONTESTED.

SOME DISTRICT QUALIFIER WILL BE HELD AFTER DECLARATIONS ARE OPEN FOR NATIONAL QUALIFIERS. COACHES, ATHLETES AND PARENTS SHOULD NOT START THE DECLARATION PROCESS FOR THE NATIONAL QUALIFIER UNTIL THE TEAM OR ATHLETES HAVE FINISH COMPETING IN ALL OF THE DISTRICT QUALIFIER THAT THEY HAVE CHOSEN TO COMPETE.

ONCE A TEAM HAS ENTER ANYONE ON THE TEAM IN A NATIONAL QUALIFIER, THE TEAM ENTRY IS CREATED AND NO CHANGES TO MARKS WILL BE ACCEPTED, SO IF A TEAM GOES TO A DISTRICT, THEN DECLARE FOR A NATIONAL QUALIFIER, THEN GOES TO ANOTHER DISTRICT QUALIFIER; THE MARKS FROM THE 2ND DISTRICT WILL NOT BE ADVANCE.

ATHLETES:

TOP 8 FINISHER 100M DASH AND 200M DASH ADVANCE TO FINAL.

15-16 GIRLS/BOYS AND 17-18 WOMEN/MEN WILL BE REQUIRED TO USE STARTING BLOCKS IN THE 100/200/400/ 100/110/400 METER HURDLES 4x1,4x4 RELAY.

RELAYS TEAMS MUST BE DECLARE ON THE REGION NATIONAL QUALIFIER LEVEL.
ALL RELAY TEAM ATHLETES MUST BE DECLARING AT THAT TIME WHICH INCLUDES ALTERNATES.

CHALLENGE PERIOD:

ALL CHALLENGES TO MEET RESULT MUST BE INITIATED WITHIN 5 DAYS OF THE DAY OF THE MEET. ALL CHALLENGES MUST BE E-MAILED TO THE DISTRICT OR NATIONAL QUALIFIER MEET DIRECTOR. AFTER 5 DAYS, RESULT WILL NOT BE CHANGE. THE 5 DAYS BEGIN ON THE DATE THE RESULTS ARE POSTED ON THE AAU WEBSITE. ALL POSTED RESULTS WILL LIST THE DATE THAT THE CHALLENGE PERIOD ENDS.

- **EARLY SO THAT THE OFFICIAL CAN START THAT EVENT WITHOUT DELAY.**
- **NO COACHES OR ATHLETES ALLOWED ON INFIELD AREA FOR ANY REASON.**

ATHLETES MUST SUPPLY THEIR OWN JAVELIN (600-800 gr) and DISCUS.

NO TRAINING OR RUBBER DISCUS TO BE USED. SHOT PUT and TURBO JAV WILL BE PROVIDED. LONG JUMP 4' OR 8' BOARD.

ATHLETES MAY ONLY USE STARTING BLOCKS SUPPLIED BY MEET MANAGEMENT.

RELAYS: YOU MAY HAVE UP TO EIGHT (8) REGISTERED ATHLETES NAME ON RELAYS ROSTER. YOU MUST DECLARE RELAY AS, A, B, C, OR D.

PROTEST: ALL PROTEST MUST BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING BY HEAD COACH OR IN CASE OF UNATTACHED ATHLETE BY PARENT WITHIN 30MIN OF INFRACTION AND HANDED TO MEET REFEREE W/ \$75.00 CASH DEPOSIT. PROTEST MAY BE APPEAL (WHICH A JURY OF APPEAL DECISION IS FINAL). IF PROTEST IS UPHOLD, CASH DEPOSIT WILL BE RETURN.
