## **Fees:**

Entry fee is \$25.00 for *each athlete*. No entry fee will be transferred or refunded. **Entry will not be processed unless entry fee is paid by deadline. Bring a legible copy of a birth certificate or proof of age, along with a 2018 AAU membership card for each athlete entered; AAU memberships must be purchased in advance and cannot be processed onsite. You can obtain your AAU membership by visiting [www.aauathletics.org](http://www.aauathletics.org). All entry fees must be paid online, no exceptions will be granted.**

## **Eligibility:**

This meet is open to any athlete that falls within the age divisions listed below and who qualified to advance in either the AAU Indiana District Qualifier or the AAU Illinois District Qualifier. The top sixteen (16) athletes in each running event, field event and rely event advance from the District Meet to the Regional Qualifier. Athletes aged 13 and older may enter in up to a maximum of 4 events including relays. Younger age brackets may only enter in 3 events including relays. Designation as a relay team member or rely team alternate will be considered as 1 event for an athlete. There will be no exceptions to the advancement procedures. Athletes may only compete in the events in which he/she qualified at the District Qualifier. Athletes may only compete in the AAU Regional Qualifier that encompasses the District Qualifier in which the athlete competed. **If an athlete is entered into too many events, meet management reserves the right to reject the athlete from one or more events without notification.**

## **Advancement to AAU Junior Olympics:**

Those athletes that qualify for the AAU Junior Olympic Games in Des Moines, Iowa must declare and register for the meet at [www.aauathletics.org](http://www.aauathletics.org) before July 17, 2018. No entries will be accepted after midnight EDT (9:00 p.m. PDT) on July 17, 2018. Do not jeopardize your athlete's change of competing in the AAU Junior Olympic Games by not completing this step in the registration process.

1. Running Events: Top six (6) athletes advance
2. Field Events: Top six (6) athletes advance
3. Relays: Top four (6) teams advance

## **Multi-Events/Steeplechase:**

The Regional Qualifier for athletes participating in multi-events or steeplechase will be contested on Thurs-Fri, June 7-8, 2018 at the 2018 AAU Northern Outdoor National Invitational at the Joliet Memorial Stadium, 3000 West Jefferson Street, Joliet Illinois 60435. ## **Protests:**

There will be a \$100.00 fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted to the Protest Referee at once and not later than 30 minutes after a result has been announced. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

## **Entry Process:**

### **Teams:**

All teams and unattached athletes must utilize the Coach O online entry process via [www.AAUAthletics.org](http://www.AAUAthletics.org) and follow the district qualifying meet links. This will permit a very efficient registration process that is easy to use. Teams will have until 11:59pm EDT, Tuesday, June 26, 2018 to complete registration. Please note that you must pay for your entries with a credit card online or your entries will not be accepted.

Immediately after registering online, teams will receive a receipt from the website, which will produce a list of all athletes registered for the meet. This receipt should be used as your transcript of your meet entries. If your athletes do not appear on the confirmation, they are not registered for the meet. Please take care of these issues prior to arriving at the meet, if at all possible.

## **Age Divisions:**

Age divisions are determined by year of birth. Listed below are the events that will take place in each age division. The 17-18 division is open to anyone who was born in or prior to 2000 and will not turn 19 years of age on the final day of the national meet.

### Check-In Requirements:

A packet will be provided for each team consisting of competition numbers, team roster, and events entered. A team representative will be responsible for picking up the packets. Packets can be picked up at the track facility beginning at 8:00am on meet day. Be sure to bring birth certificates and AAU cards with when you pick up packets.

### Awards:

In individual events, medals will be presented for participants who finish 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> place and ribbons for 4<sup>th</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place. Medals will be presented for the top 3 relay teams.

### Officials:

### Facility:

The track at Warren Central High School is an 8-lane all-weather surface. Only ¼” or smaller pyramid spikes are allowed. Fully Automatic Timing & results will be done using FinishLynx Cameras interfaced with Hy-Tek Meet Manager. No smoking, radios, glass containers, or alcoholic beverages are allowed in the facility. We are also pleased to have FloTrak offer live streaming of the event.

### Refreshments:

A Full Service Concession Stand and a variety of other food service vendors will be available in addition to a hospitality area for officials.

**Equipment:**

Starting blocks and throwing implements will be provided by the meet management. For field events, athletes should bring their own personal implements with them. These personal implements must obtain clearance from the meet official prior to use and they will not be released until the end of the competition for that age group. Batons will **not** be supplied.

**Admission:**

A daily admission charge of \$10.00 will be assessed for everyone not competing in the meet or a two-day pass will be available for \$15.00.
