RELAY RULE CHANGE: USATF Competition Rule #170 Relay Races /Pg. 80/ Par 3. In the 4x100m, and the 4x200m, the first and second exchanges in the 'Swedish' Medley and the outdoor Sprint Medley relays, each (takeover) exchange zone shall be **30m long**, of which the scratch line is 20m from the start of zone.

THE EXCHANGE ZONE IS NOW 30M LONG.

ALL FIELD EVENTS: THREE (3) ATTEMPTS ONLY. EXCEPTION, POLE VAULT, HIGH JUMP

ALL RUNNING EVENTS REPORT TO THE "CLERK OF COURSE"

FIELD EVENTS REPORT DIRECTLY TO THAT EVENT, CHECK IN WITH HEAD OFFICIAL.

1/4" SPIKES PYRAMIDS ONLY ON ALL TRACK SURFACES. NO CHRISTMAS TREE

TRAINER(S) WILL BE ON SITE DURNING COMPETETION.

MEMBERS OF RELAY TEAMS MUST WEAR THE SAME TEAM COLOR JERSEY AND SHORTS.

ONLY COMPETITION UNIFORM WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE CLERKING AREA

NO "BARE MIDRIFF" RULE IN EFFECT. NO WALKING AROUND BARECHESTED.

NO ONE ALLOWED ON THE INFIELD FOR ANY REASON, UNLESS REQUESTED BY MEET DIRECTOR

NO LISTING DEVICES ALLOWED BY ATHLETE WHILE WARMING UP ON TRACK & FIELD.

NO ELECTRONICS, GLASS, RADIOS, WATER GUNS, ALCOHOL, OR SMOKING PERMITTED ON SCHOOL PROPERTY. NO RECORDING DEVICES, PHONES, TABLETS ALLOWED IN COMPETITION AREA.

NO ATHLETE, COACH, OR PERSONS, ALLOWED IN ANY BUILDING, ROOMS, EQUIPMENT OR PASSAGEWAY.

SHOT PUT AND TURBO JAVELIN WITH BE SUPPLY.

ALL RUNNING EVENTS ARE TIMED FINALS.

UNSPORTMAN LIKE CONDUCT, INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR APPLIES TO ATHLETES, COACHES, AND ANYONE ASSOCIATED WITH ATHLETE AND/OR TEAM.

PLEASE NOTE THAT WHILE AN ATHLETE CAN DECLARE ALL EVENTS WITH MARK ACHIEVED AT THE DISTRICT QUALIFIER, THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER EVENTS THAT WERE NOT COMPETED AT A DISTRICT QUALIFIER WITH A NO MARK AT THE NATIONAL QUALIFIER.

RELAYS TEAMS MUST BE DECLARE ON THE REGION NATIONAL QUALIFIER LEVEL.

SOME DISTRICT QUALIFIER WILL BE HELD AFTER DECLARATIONS ARE OPEN FOR NATIONAL QUALIFIERS. COACHES, ATHLETES AND PARENTS SHOULD NOT START THE DECLARATION PROCESS FOR THE NATIONAL QUALIFIER UNTIL THE TEAM OR ATHLETES HAVE FINISH COMPETING IN ALL OF THE DISTRICT QUALIFIER THAT THEY HAVE CHOSEN TO COMPETE.

ONCE A TEAM HAS ENTER ANYONE ON THE TEAM IN A NATIONAL QUALIFIER, THE TEAM ENTRY IS CREATED, NO CHANGES TO MARKS WILL BE ACCEPTED. SO IF A TEAM GOES TO A DISTRICT QUALIFIER, THEN DECLARE FOR A NATIONAL QUALIFIER, THEN GOES TO ANOTHER DISTRICT QUALIFIER; THE MARKS FROM THE 2ND DISTRICT WILL NOT BE ADVANCE.

ATHLETE REGISTRATION: ATHLETE EVENT ENTRIES MUST BE COMPLETED AND SUBMITTED BEFORE DEADLINE TIME EXPIRE. ANY ENTRIES THAT HAS NOT BEEN COMPLETED BEFORE DEADLINE TIME EXPIRE WILL BE LOCKED OUT AND NOT ENTERED.

COACHES AND ATHLETES WILL BE ISSUED A COLOR CODE WRIST BAND FOR ADMISSION (INCLUDE IN TEAM PACKET).

ONE (1) COACHES BAND PER (6) REGISTER ATHLETES, MAX 6 BAND ISSUED. UNATTACHED ATHLETE WILL BE ISSUED ONE (1) BAND ATHLETE AND ONE BAND (1) COACH.

RUNNING EVENTS: REPORT TO CLERK OF COURSE IMMEDIATELY WHEN CALLED OR YOU WILL FORFEIT YOUR ABILITY TO COMPETE IN THAT EVENT.

FIELD EVENTS: ATHLETES WHO FAIL TO REPORT PRIOR TO THE COMPLETION OF FIRST ATTEMPT OF THEIR DESIGNATED FLIGHT ATHLETE WILL FORFEIT THEIR ABILITY TO COMPETE IN THAT EVENT. ONCE EVENT HAS STARTED NO RUN THROUGH OR RUN BACK. IF NOT ENOUGH OFFICIALS TO STAFF 2 LONG JUMP PITS, ONLY 1 PIT WILL BE IN USE.

TENT PLACEMENT:

NO TENTS/SHADEING DEVICES, OR TENT LEG/FRAME TO EXTENDED BELOW BOTTOM 3RD ROW. NO ALL TENTS /SHADING DEVICE MUST BE STAKED WEIGHTED/TIE DOWN. NO TENTS MAY HINDER PASSAGE/WALK THROUGHS OR MOVEMENT OF ATHLETE, SPECTATORS OR MEET PERSONAL.

REMOVE COVER AND/OR LOWER TENT EACH NIGHT.



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RELAY ATHLETES MUST WEAR SAME COLOR JERSEY (TOP) AND SHORTS (BOTTOMS).
RELAYS TEAMS ARE ALLOWED 4 PRIMARY MEMBERS AND UP TO 4 ALTERNATE MEMBERS NAMES (TOTAL 8), TO BE DECLARED AT TIME OF ENTRY INTO MEET. RELAY TEAM MUST BE DESIGNATED AS A, B, C, or D.

ALL PROTEST MUST BE IN WRITING WITHIN 30 MIN. OF INFRACTION AND HANDED TO MEET REFEREE, ALONG WITH A CASH DEPOSIT OF \$50.00. CASH DEPOSIT WILL BE REFUNDED IF THE PROTEST IS UPHELD. (Protest form located in awards) **A JUDGEMENT CALL IS NOT PROTESTABLE.**

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Advancement to the AAU Junior Olympic Games:

District Qualifier: The top sixteen (16) finishers in each individual event, relays, or multi-event shall advance from the District Qualifier to the National Qualifier. Competitors shall only advance from the District Qualifier into the Regional Qualifier in the events that they actually **competed and qualified** at the District level.

Regional Qualifier:

To advance to the 2019 AAU Junior Olympic Games from an AAU Track & Field Regional Qualifier, an athlete need to finish in the top six (6) in a Running Event, top six(6) Field Event, top (6) in a Relay and top four (4) Multi-Event.
