## Eligibility

This meet is open to any athlete that falls within the age divisions listed below. AAU individual and club memberships can be obtained through the AAU National Website, www.aausports.org. Each athlete aged 13-18 may enter in up to a maximum of 4 events including relays. Athletes aged 12 and younger based on year of birth below, may only enter in 3 events including relays. Athletes aged 19 \& older aren't restricted to if an athlete is entered into too many events, meet management reserves the right to reject the athlete from one or more events without notification

## Age Divisions

Age divisions are determined by year of birth. Listed below are the AAU Age Divisions.

| $19 \&$ Older Women/Men (Born 2001 \& Earlier) | Unlimited Events |

*Athletes who are born in 2001 and will not turn 19 years of age during the meet are eligible to compete in the
17-18 Womens/Mens divisions. Anyone who is 19 or older must compete in the Open division.

## Fees

Entry fee is $\$ 35.00$ for each athlete for Youth track and field events. No entry fee will be transferred or refunded. Entry will not be processed unless entry fee is paid by deadline. Bring a legible copy of a birth certificate or proof of age, along with a 2020 AAU membership card for each athlete entered; Do not send in advance. All entry fees must be paid online.

## Entry Process

## Teams

All teams and unattached athletes must utilize the online entry process via www.aauathletics.org. Everyone will have until 9 PM CST, Monday, January $13^{\text {TH }}$ to complete registration. Immediately after registering online, you will receive a receipt from the website, which will produce a list of all athletes registered for the meet. This receipt should be used as your transcript of your meet entries. If your athletes do not appear on the confirmation, they are not registered for the meet. Absolutely no entries will be accepted after January $13^{\mathrm{TH}}$.

## Packet Pickup

A packet will be provided for each team consisting of team roster and events entered. A team representative will be responsible for picking up the packets. All teams are urged to pickup packets on Saturday during the early pickup times of Noon-5 PM as the lines during the meet can be long. Packets can be picked up at the Huff Athletic Center on Saturday, January 18 ${ }^{\text {TH }}$ from 12:00-7:00 PM and on Sunday, January 19 ${ }^{\text {TH }}$, from 7:00-11:00 AM. Be sure to bring birth certificates and 2019 AAU cards with you when you pick up packets.

## Awards

In individual events, awards will be presented for participants who finish $1^{\text {ST}}-8^{\text {TH }}$ place. Relay participants will receive awards for $1^{\text {ST }}-3^{\mathrm{RD}}$ place finishes.

## Team Awards

Each event will be scored. Teams that finish $1^{\text {ST }}$ in each age division will be awarded a plaque. The top 3 teams that accumulate the most points throughout the meet will be awarded trophies as well. Team awards will be presented at the conclusion of the meet in an award ceremony.

## Facility

The facility boasts a 8-lane straightaway as well as providing 6 lanes around the oval. Only $1 / 4$ " or smaller pyramid spikes are allowed. Fully Automatic Timing \& results will be done by AdkinsTrak Timing Associates using Finishlynx Cameras interfaced with Hy-Tek Meet Manager. No radios, glass containers, or alcoholic beverages are allowed in the facility.

## Refreshments

A Full Service Concession Stand operated by Monmouth College will be provided as well as a hospitality area for officials.

## Equipment

Starting blocks will be provided by the meet management. There is no need to bring any with you. Those that desire to utilize personal implements must obtain clearance from the event official prior to use. If personal implements are used, they will not be released until the end of the competition for that age group.

## Admission

A charge of $\$ 8.00$ admission will be assessed for everyone not competing in the meet. Teams will be given coaches passes for every 10 competitors participating in the meet up to a maximum of 5 .

## Restricted Area

Only credentialed coaches and athletes competing in the meet will be permitted floor or track level access. All others will be permitted to sit in the stands on the main level. Teams will receive up to 5 coach passes and will be earned on a basis of 1 per each 10 athletes entered into the meet. Additional coach passes may be purchased for $\$ 15.00$. To order additional passes, please contact the meet director at marchan@adkinstrak.com. Coach passes will not be available on site in the ticket booth. You must pre-order.

## Airline Travel

Monmouth is about an 1 hour from Peoria International Airport (PIA) and 90 minutes from Bloomington Airport (BMI), almost 3 hours away from Chicago Airports, and 3 hours from St. Louis airport.
