QUALIFICATIONS: Open event. You do not have to qualify to participate in this National Championship.

AGE DIVISIONS: Girls' Divisions: 18U, 16U, 15U, 14U, 12U, 10U (Athletes may only enter 1 division)

10 & Under – Must be born on or after September 1, 2007
12 & Under – Must be born on or after September 1, 2005
14 & Under – Must be born on or after September 1, 2003
15 & Under – Must be born on or after September 1, 2002
16 & Under – Must be born on or after September 1, 2001
18 & Under – Must be born on or after September 1, 1999

OR players who were born on or after September 1, 1998 AND be a high school student (12th grade or below) during some part of the current academic year.

Once a player participates in a club or varsity program for any university, college, community college or junior college, he or she is ineligible to play in the National Championships.

FORMAT: 3-Day Format:

Day 1: Pool Play followed by a second round of pool play Day 2: Pool Play for seeding and determining bracket levels

Day 3: Single Elimination Playoffs

2-Day Format:

Day 1: Pool Play followed by a second round of pool play

Day 2: Single Elimination Playoffs

1-Day Format:

Day 1: Pool Play followed by single elimination playoffs

All teams will advance to the final day of competition for their division.

*Competition times for the first day of competition will be emailed closer to the tournament. Once the tournament begins, check in with the Tournament Tent or tournament personnel for daily updates.

** The format of the tournament and the start time is subject to change.

AAU MEMBERSHIP:

All athletes must be current AAU members. AAU membership is \$14.00 per athlete. The cost of membership is in addition to the entry fee. To join, visit www.aaubeach.org.

ENTRY FEE:

Girls 16, 18 - \$95 per player (\$190 per team) Girls 12, 14, 15 - \$75 per player (\$150 per team) Girls 10 - \$45 per player (\$90 per team)

All participants will receive a participation certificate and T-Shirt.

ENTRY DEADLINE &

EVENT REGISTRATION: All teams must register by Sunday, July 1, 2018. All entry fees are non-refundable.

**Registration may reach capacity before the entry deadline and is first come, first served. There will be a waitlist when divisions fill and teams will be taken in the order they are registered on the waitlist. There is no guarantee that waitlist teams will be entered into the tournament.

How to Register:

- You must first be AAU members (both players) before registering for the event. If you are not an AAU member, visit www.aausports.org and join online. AAU membership is \$14 per athlete. Once you join online, you will be able to print your membership card with your membership number. You will need your membership number to sign-up for the AAU Junior Olympic Games.
- Register for the event at www.aaubeach.org. Both partners will need to register at one time and pay the Team Entry Fee. Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover are accepted.

RULES:

USAV/FIVB rules, as modified by the AAU Beach Volleyball Committee. The AAU Beach Volleyball Committee reserves the right to make decisions pertaining to entries, rules, and general procedures governing tournaments. Teams will be required to officiate matches. During pool play, officiating assignments will be scheduled. During bracket play, the losing team must officiate. The penalty for not fulfilling assignments is elimination from further AAU Beach Volleyball Tournaments.

UNIFORMS:

All girls' teams must wear uniform tops with #1 and #2 OR have temp tattoo numbers visible.

* #1 and #2 should be denoted alphabetically by last names of players.

* Temporary Tattoos will be sold on site for those teams that may need them.

AWARDS:

Medals will be awarded to the top four (4) teams.

Top one (1) team in consolation brackets will receive a medal.

COACHES'

EDUCATION:
