

# 2011 SEEDING BOY'S AAU 8TH GRADE DIVISION III NATIONAL BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS

**8<sup>th</sup> Grade Seeding:** Seeding based on the 2010: 13 and Under/7<sup>th</sup> Grade Championship results from Hampton Roads, Virginia; the 2009: 12 and Under/6<sup>th</sup> Grade National Championship results from Hampton Roads, Virginia.

- Seeding shall be by districts, not individual teams.
- The first criterion for seeding shall be order of finish in the respective age division for three (3) years when possible. Only teams advancing out of pool play to the championship round will receive points for seeding if they placed in the top sixteen (16) places.
1. National Classic Championships does not count towards seeding.
  2. District 2nd, 3rd, 4th etc. teams will retain points.
- C. **Based on a point system, districts will be placed in order, with the highest total of points first and so on. The host team shall be the 9th seed in all tournaments.**
- Ties are broken by best finish in latest event.
- D. **All Districts were drawn, blind by the voting delegates at the National convention in order to establish the order of placement in pools after the seeded teams are placed.**
- E. The order of placement is as follows:
1. Seeded teams in order.
  2. Removal of seeded teams from placement list
  3. Removal of teams not participating from list
  4. After the seeded teams, silver teams of seeded teams will be added in order of seeded teams. Districts with points will retain their spot in list from points they receive.
  5. Teams are advanced upward to fill vacated spots except the host team, which shall remain 9th place in all tournaments. Host district gold medal team will be placed according to point total.
  6. The order of the draw list shall apply to Gold medal teams. Silver teams are then placed, then bronze, then 4th, then 5th etc., exempt according to the draw.
  7. Pool winners and runners-ups advance to championship bracket play. The 3rd, 4th, 5th place teams in each pool will play in the National Classic Championship.
  8. Exempt teams will be placed after the final team for each district. Exempt teams that place in their District will keep District placement.
- The local host committee is not involved in the placement of teams into pools. Order of pool play and bracket schedule are predetermined and submitted to the Local Host by the National Director of Competition.
