The order of the draw list shall apply to Gold medal teams, Silver teams, Bronze teams, then 4th etc

Pool winner and runner-up advance to championship bracket play.

The 3rd, 4th, 5th place teams in each pool will play in the National Classic Championship.

District placement will determine placement of teams into the Pool Play.

The local host committee is not involved in the placement of teams into pools. Order of pool play and bracket schedule are predetermined and submitted to the Local Host by the National Director of Competition who has the final determination.
