In case of a tie coming in standings, the national AAU tie-breaker formula will be applied. In any situation where two teams are tied, head to head competition between the teams will determine the winner. If more than two teams tie, a point differential tie-breaker will be applied. The point differentials of the teams involved in the tie are totaled. (The maximum that you can beat a team and still gain an advantage is 15 points). Teams are then ranked according to the sum of the point differential, with the highest number placing first, etc. If more than two teams are still tied after the application of the formula, the point differential of the teams not involved in the tie, are added and the result recalculated.

ADMISSION:

Adults \$8.00 per game, Students ages 7 to 17- \$5.00 per game Event Pass: Adult \$25.00, Student ages 7 to 17- \$15.00. Children 6 and under are free.

Daily Pass (Sunday Only): Adult \$15.00, Student ages 7 to 17-\$8.00. Children 6 and under are free.

TEAMS PLAY MULTIPLE GAMES IN ONE DAY. IF YOU PURCHASE AN EVENT PASS, YOU CAN ENTER AND LEAVE THE GYMS AS YOU WISH. IF YOU PAY A \$8.00 GAME ADMISSSION, AND LEAVE THE GYM AND WANT TO RE-ENTER, YOU WILL NEED TO PAY ANOTHER \$8.00 GAME ADMISSION FOR THE NEXT GAME YOU WATCH.

TEAMS MAY PLAY MULTIPLE GAMES ON MULTIPLE DAYS IN MUTIPLE GYMS. A Daily (Sunday Only) AND AN EVENT PASS ALLOWS YOU TO ENTER AND LEAVE THE GYM(S) AS YOU WISH.

Each team is responsible for warm-up balls, uniforms, etc.

Top Four (4) teams advance to the 6th Grade Division I State Championship May 23-25, 2014 in White House, TN. All other teams are eligible to advance to the 6th Grade Division II Championship May 23-26, 2014 in Franklin, TN.
