In case of a tie coming in standings, the national AAU tiebreaker formula will be applied. In any situation where two teams are tied, head to head competition between the teams will determine the winner. If more than two teams tie, a point differential tiebreaker will be applied. The point differentials of the teams involved in the tie are totaled. (The maximum that you can beat a team and still gain an advantage is 15 points). Teams are then ranked according to the sum of the point differential, with the highest number placing first, etc. If more than two teams are still tied after the application of the formula, the point differential of the teams not involved in the tie, are added and the result recalculated.
