Tournament Rules & Information

- Each team (players and coaches) must sign in prior to its first game. Sign-in sheets will be available near the entrance to each gym. Please have copies of birth certificates, AAU membership cards, and an official AAU roster ready to present upon check-in.
- Coaches must adhere to AAU dress code (collared shirt, no shorts, no jeans, no hats, no open-toed shoes). AAU rules regarding violations will be followed, without exception.
- Coaches must fill out a score sheet prior to each game. These will be available at the scorer's tables. Sheets must be filled out completely, with each player's first and last name and number provided.
- Teams must provide their own warm-up basketballs. Game balls will be provided.
- Teams listed on the left are the home teams, will wear the light-colored uniforms and will sit to the left of the scorer's table facing the floor.
- No team personnel will be allowed at the scorer's tables.
- AAU tie-breaker procedures will be followed. They are:
 - Head-to-head (two-way tie)
 - Point differential between *only* the teams involved (three-way tie). 15-point maximum differential.
- Each team will be allowed 10 minutes to warm up, with a 5-minute halftime.
- All other AAU rules will be followed. Overtimes will be 4 minutes in length.
- All officials are TSSAA-certified. All table personnel are current/former college athletes.
- Admission is \$5 per game, or \$20 for a weekend pass. Weekend passes are good for all games at all gyms. No passes out.
- No outside food or drink is allowed.
