AGE

DETERMINATION:

October 1, 2010/school grade shall be the age determination date. For more information please visit www.aaugirlsbasketball.org All players' proof of age will be verified by the on-line registration. The head coach must have copies of players' birth certificates at the tournament as well as any other pertinent forms.

TEAM ROSTER:

Team rosters will be limited to 15 players and four coaches throughout the Virginia District Tournament. Note: Only those persons listed on the team roster may sit on the bench. Each person on the bench MUST have an AAU Membership card.

You may need this form or a similar form to authorize medical treatment, especially if the parents are not available. This form is provided for your convenience. If medical treatment is required in connection with any AAU sanction event, you may obtain an AAU insurance claim form from the tournament director or the Virginia District AAU office. AAU insurance is "secondary" insurance unless The patient has no other coverage, in which case the AAU becomes "primary" insurance.

TEAM CHECK IN:
