DATES:	Friday, May 22 nd – Monday, May 25 th , 2015
LOCATION:	The HP Field House (Six court facility) and Jostens® Center (Six court facility) at the spectacular ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex - 700 Victory Way, Kissimmee, FL 34747 - and other sites as needed. <u>Teams are not guaranteed to play any games at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex.</u>
GRADE DIVISIONS:	The Memorial Day Classic has separate Division I & Division II portions of the tournament. The grades being contested at this event are: 3 rd 4 th 5 th 6 th 7 th 8 th 9 th 10 th 11 th 12 th (To find out what grade division your team qualifies for refer to the AAU Girls Basketball Handbook)
ENTRY FEE:	Entry fee for 2014 Memorial Day Classic is \$450.00. All tournament registration will be online. Please visit <u>www.aaugirlsbasketball.org</u>
ENTRY DEADLINE:	Thursday, April 30 th , 2015 at 11:59 PM EST. Register early for this popular event. Openings are limited.
REGISTRATION:	 Will be held on Friday, May 22nd, 2015 from 2pm – 9pm at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex. A person listed as bench personnel shall register the team two (2) hours prior to your first game. All team registration shall occur at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex. Each team shall present an <u>"ELIGIBILITY BOOK"</u> for review. The <u>"ELIGIBILITY BOOK"</u> must contain: Copy of the team AAU Online Roster to be used at the event. Copy of each athlete's Proof of Grade. Copy of each athlete's Proof of Age. The <u>"ELIGIBILITY BOOK"</u> may be held at registration for review or requested to be seen by a member of the AAU Staff during the tournament. Any book held for review shall be returned to the team. Failure to have proper documentation at registration or during the event may result in athlete or team disqualification. COACH VERIFICATION:	All bench personnel must be present and show government issued photo ID in order to receive credentials. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS</u>
SCHEDULE/RESULTS:	Schedules will be posted at <u>www.aaugirlsbasketball.org</u> . A pool play system will be used, leading to a Championship Bracket. Teams must play all scheduled games or penalties will be applied. <u>Play</u> <u>will begin at 4:00 PM on Friday May 22nd</u> . If your team cannot meet the start times on Friday, please refrain from entering the tournament.
RULES OF PLAY:	Competition will follow the rules and regulations as specified in the AAU Girls Basketball Handbook, please visit <u>www.aaugirlsbasketball.org</u> and click on the Rules/Info tab, then Rule Book.

UNIFORMS:	The top team on the bracket or the first team listed on the pool play pairings shall be the home team and shall wear <u>LIGHT</u> . Players' jerseys must have numbers on both the front and back. Numbers can be 00-99. Minimum size of numbers shall be 2" on the front and 4" on the back. Teams competing in National Championship tournaments must have <u>LIGHT</u> and <u>DARK</u> jerseys. Violation of this rule shall be penalized by a two (2) shot technical foul for each illegal jersey, to be assessed at the time the player with the illegal jersey enters the game. <u>We highly</u> <u>recommend you bring both LIGHT and DARK uniforms to each scheduled game.</u>
TEAM ROSTER:	AAU rules allow a maximum of 15 players and 4 coaches on the roster. Rosters must be submitted online. All participants and coaches must be members of the Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) for the current year. Membership can be obtained at <u>www.aausports.org</u> .
ELIGIBILITY:	Any questions pertaining to the eligibility of a player or team shall be directed to the Tournament Director or his/her designee in attendance.
AWARDS:	AAU medals and trophies will be awarded to first (1) and second (2) place teams. The top four (4) finishers in each grade division in all tournaments will receive a CONDITIONAL bid into the 2015 AAU Girls Basketball National Championships.
QUALIFICATION:	Teams that qualify for the National Championship <u>MUST</u> play in their District Qualifying Tournament (DQT) to validate their bid.
WARM-UP & GAME BALLS:	Basketballs are provided during warm-up sessions and games. DO NOT bring basketballs to games.
SPECTATOR ADMISSION:	Daily admission will be available, \$17.00 per adult and \$12.00 per youth (ages 3-9). Length of Event tickets are available, \$51.00 per adult and \$36.00 per youth. Tickets may be purchased at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex, Box Office. (Prices are subject to change)
