- District Regional Team Competition as determined by each AAU District Chair
- Individual Competition

Individual Competition

- AAU National Routines and Rules will be used go to <u>www.aausports.org</u> and click gymnastics
- All competitors must have a current 2015 AAU number. Go to www.aausposrts.org and select JOIN.
- Levels 1,2,3,4,5,6, all Xcel levels, and Open Optional (level 9 rules with possibility of level 10 bonus)
- Age Groups gymnasts will be divided by dates of birth in each level.
- Awards for Individual Competition $-\frac{1}{2} + 1$ for individuals on events
- Awards for All-Around 100%

Regional Team Competition

Regional teams will be determined by each individual district, whether by specific qualifying meet, state/district championship, or other means. Please check with the district chair of your state. Regional team members must be pre-determined and named on entry form.

- A regional team as **determined by each individual district** will consist of a maximum of six (6) gymnasts in each level/age group. The top three scores on each individual event will count for team total for that district. These six named gymnasts will compete as Team #1 for named district. In addition, if number of entries allow, finishers 7-12 will compete as Team #2. Three (3) alternates can be named to Team #2.
- In the event of a Team #1 member being unable to compete, the next gymnast in line will move to her spot and all others below will move up one spot. The first place finisher on Team #2 will move to Team #1 and alternates will move into team spot. Substitutions can occur until the beginning of the first warm up rotation of the meet.
- **Age groups for Regional Team Competition as determined by districts will be as follows:
 - o LEVEL 1: 6-8 year olds, 9-10 year olds, 11 and older
 - o LEVEL 2: 6 year olds, 7-8 year olds, 9-10 year olds, 11 and older
 - o LEVEL 3: 8 years and younger, 9-10 year olds, 11 and older
 - o LEVEL 4: 8 years and younger, 9-10 year olds, 11 and older
 - o LEVEL 5: 8 years and younger, 9-10 year olds, 11 and older
 - LEVEL 6: 8 years and younger, 9 and older
 - Xcel Bronze: 6 year olds, 7-8 year olds, 9-10 year olds, 11 and older
 - O Xcel Silver: 6 year olds, 7-8 year olds, 9-10 year olds, 11 and older
 - Xcel Gold: 8 years and younger, 9-10 year olds, 11 and older
 - Excel Platinum: 8 years and younger, 9-10 year olds, 11 and older
 - o Xcel Diamond: 8 years and younger, 9-10 year olds, 11 and older
 - Levels 7, 8,9,10: 10 years and younger, 11 and older
 - ** Age is determined by the start date of the competition.

Important Notice – The above age divisions are for district regional teams only. For individual competition, gymnasts will be divided by dates of birth. No ability levels will apply (ex. – novice, advanced, etc).

Named district regional team members will compete at the championships at the same time as individuals and will be eligible for individual awards as well as regional team awards.



Awards For District Regional Teams

EACH member of the regional team in each level will receive an award, as team members may be from different clubs.
