**XIII FIRS Senior Women Inline Hockey World Championships** – Toulouse, France – Arrival - Sunday, June 29, Official Practice - Monday, June 30, Competitions - Tuesday, July 1 through Saturday, July 6, Departure - Monday, July 7, 2014. A team consisting of up to 16 members (including two goalies) will be selected. Partial funding as noted below will only be offered to 10 floor players and 2 goalies. Beyond that number must be responsible for all expenses. (USA departure and practice in Philadelphia on June 28)

**XX FIRS Senior Men Inline Hockey World Championships** – Toulouse, France – Arrival - Sunday, July 6, Official Training – Monday, July 7, Competitions - Tuesday, July 8 through Saturday, July 13, Departure July 14, 2014 - A team consisting of up to 16 athletes (including two goalies) will be selected to participate. Partial funding as noted below will only be offered to 12 floor players and 2 goalies. Beyond that number must be responsible for all expenses. (USA departure on July 5)

**Women's Team Eligibility:** Female athletes must meet the following criteria:

- Senior Minimum age is **fourteen (14)** years as calculated on January 1 in the year of the Championship.
- Athlete must be a current member of USA Roller Sports. A membership application is available at <http://usarollersports.org/resources/forms> - memberships expire annually on December 31
- Passport proof of U.S. citizenship required - only U.S. citizens are eligible to represent our country at the FIRS World Championships.

**Men's Team Eligibility:** Open to eligible male players who in 2013 have *competed* in national level events sanctioned by USA Roller Sports (including those co-sponsored by member organizations of USARS).

In addition, selected athletes must meet the following criteria:

- Senior Minimum age is **fourteen (14)** years as calculated on January 1st in the year of the Championship. **ADVISORY:** It is recommended that USA male competitors, ages 14 and 15, should try out for the Junior Team USA. This will provide a better opportunity at the trials for success. As a Junior Team member they will obtain more playing experience at a World Championships in preparation for entry into the more experienced Senior level competitions.
- Athlete must be a current member of USA Roller Sports. A membership application is available at <http://usarollersports.org/resources/forms> - memberships expire annually on December 31.
- Passport proof of U.S. citizenship required - only U.S. citizens are eligible to represent our country at the FIRS World Championships.

**Responsibility of Senior World Championship Teams** – The cost of participation is estimated to be up to \$3,500, subject to air travel cost. Senior Team members must pay \$1,995 toward this amount, which includes an estimated cost for *international* air travel, hotel with three meals a day, ground transportation in France, travel insurance, etc. Senior Women will meet in Philadelphia (*domestic* travel to Philly not in above budget). If flying from the West Coast, arrival in Philadelphia would be for early on June 28, to permit a couple of practice sessions in the morning and early afternoon, prior to departure for France. Travel for Senior Men to their USA international departure airport is not included in the budget above.

**APPLICATION FEE:** \$75 (includes required USARS membership). \$75 must accompany the membership and participation applications. **Deadline for Receipt of Applications** – April 7, 2014. **Team Selection Completed** – April 11, 2014.

**Team Deposit of \$1,000 due** - April 14, 2014.

**Balance not to exceed \$995 due** - May 15, 2014

- ❖ **Junior Men Championships:** 20 Teams - There will be 6 groups (JMtop8 - A, B, JMq - C, D, E, F) playing a round robin. Group A and B will qualify 6 teams, Group C,D,E, F will qualify 2 teams. These 8 teams will compete for gold, silver and bronze medals by direct elimination, 8 other teams will compete for a B World Cup by direct elimination.
- ❖ **Senior Women Championships:** 16 Teams - There will be 4 groups (JM- A, B, C, D) playing a round robin to qualify 8 teams competing for gold, silver and bronze medals by direct elimination, 8 other teams will compete for a B World Cup by direct elimination.
- ❖ **Junior Women Championships:** 8 teams, 2 groups will play a round Robin then 8 teams will compete for gold, silver and bronze medals by direct elimination.
- ❖ **Senior Men Championships:** 24 Teams - Six groups (A, B, C, D, E, F) playing a round robin. Group A and B will qualify 6 teams, Group C, D, E and F will qualify 2 teams. These eight (8) teams will compete for Gold, Silver and Bronze medals by direct elimination. All other teams will begin new competitions named World Cup B and World Cup C for National teams with first, second and third medals.

**Note: Junior Age:** The official FIRS Junior Championship age level for both male and female players is under nineteen (19). In accordance with the information given at Huntington Beach on 2013, July 14th, players born in: 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000 are eligible to play in 2014.

I understand the nature of USARS' activities and believe that I (or my minor child) am/are qualified and physically fit to participate in roller skating competitions and practices. I further acknowledge that I am aware that the activity will be conducted in facilities open to the public. As a skater, parent or legal guardian, I further agree and warrant that prior to participating in any event I will inspect the facilities to be used and if believing conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately advise my coach or the meet director of this condition and refuse to participate unless corrected.
3. I fully understand that USARS' activities involve risks and dangers of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, and economic losses which might result not only from a skater's actions, inactions or negligence, but the action, inaction, or negligence of others, the rules of competition, or the condition of the premises or any equipment in use. I fully accept and assume all such risks and responsibilities for losses and costs and damages incurred as a result of my participation in USARS activities or arising out of my traveling to or returning from such activities or practice sessions.
4. ## ACCIDENT INSURANCE INFORMATION

### Effective Date

The effective date for the USA Roller Sports excess accident/medical expense benefit program is the time the athlete signs and dates this application and remits full payment to a USARS representative, initiating the individual into the master policy and confirming membership in USA Roller Sports. This application and full payment must be received at USARS Headquarters, 4730 South Street, Lincoln, NE 68506, within 10 days of the date on the application in order for the insurance to remain valid. Giving payment to a coach or club president could compromise your insurance coverage if the preceding timeline is not followed.

### Who and What is Covered

**Competitors/Coaches**-Registered member skaters/coaches of USA Roller Sports are provided with excess (secondary) accident/medical expense benefits for injuries occurring **ON SKATES** limited to organized and supervised practice sessions held within USA Roller Sports chartered club facilities, or during USA Roller Sports sanctioned competitions and/or USA Roller Sports training sessions sanctioned by national headquarters specified to occur outside of club facilities. The event must be supervised by a club officer (or an official USA Roller Sports coach) or the USA Roller Sports designated leader of an USA Roller Sports sponsored event. The individual will be required to certify the validity of the claim being submitted. No coverage is extended to a skater injured while on skates, but who is not in training for USA Roller Sports competitions.

**Non-Competitive Card Holders/USA Roller Sports Officials**-Coverage is limited to accidents occurring both on or off skates while actually participating in a competition that is in progress.

### What is Not Covered

Training off skates or training outside of chartered club facilities, unless specified by a USA Roller Sports sanction, or any injury occurring while on skates but while not training for USA Roller Sports competitions is **not** covered. Sickness is **not** covered. Pre-existing conditions are **not** covered and shall mean any condition for which treatment has been provided within (6) months prior to such injury. Re-injury **is** considered a pre-existing condition.

**Excess Coverage**-All benefits are payable on an EXCESS BASIS. This means that your primary policy must pay the charge on each bill (that are payable under that policy's contract) before this insurance will pay. Proof of these payments must be submitted to the claims payer.

**Accident Medical Expense**-If, as a result of an injury, an insured incurs covered expenses starting within 30 days of the date of the accident, up to the maximum amount will be paid for covered expenses incurred within 26 weeks of the initial injury. For current maximum amount contact the USARS National Headquarters.

**Deductible**-A deductible is applied per accident and you are responsible for the deductible amount in Medical and/or Dental expenses before any benefits are payable. Please note that there are different deductible amounts that apply and you should refer to the actual policies for details.

**Basis For Payment**-"Usual and Customary" or "Reasonable and Customary" rates. Your doctor's billing clerk will understand these terms. You will be responsible for any amount that exceeds total payable benefit.

**Accident Report & Claims Forms** - An accident report (available online) **must** be filed with USA Roller Sports by the injured individual and signed by a club officer within 14 days of the date of injury. Claim forms will be emailed by USA Roller Sports to the injured party after receipt of a completed and signed accident report form and all insurance criteria are met. The club president must verify the rink circumstances and when the injury occurred. To initiate the claims process, contact USA Roller Sports 402.483.7551, within 14 days of the accident.
