In consideration of being allowed to participate in this event, the undersigned:

1. Acknowledge familiarity with the sport of judo and the rules governing the sport of judo.
2. Agree that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment facilities, competition pools or divisions, and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach or supervisor of such condition(s) and refuse to participate. Parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of minors agree to instruct the minor participant to this effect
3. Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due to not only my own actions, inactions or negligence, but also to the action, inaction or negligence of others, the rules of this sport of judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of judo, assume that risk and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability or death.
5. Release, waive and discharge and covenant not to sue JUDO, Inc., AAU, the National and State Judo Organizations, their affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches, and other employees or volunteers of the organization, event officials, medical personnel, other participants, their parents, guardian(s), supervisors and coaches, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners, lessors, and lessees of premises used to conduct the event, all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "releasees," from any and all claims, demands, losses, or damages on account of injury, including permanent disability and death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.
6. Parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of minor participants age 17 and below additionally agree that they will instruct the minor participant to the above warnings and conditions and their ramifications, and that they consent to the minor's participation.
7. Has received judo coach's indication of having sufficient aptitude and skill in judo to compete in this event

RULES, SCORING, MATCH TIME, ETC.

- Official AAU judo rules govern this event
- Ages 10 & under 2-minute matches • All others 3-minutes
- Chokes ages 11 and up • Armbar ages 15 and up.
- Either "Round Robin", "Double Elimination", "True Winners Repechage with Consolation" or "Scrambles" will be used for elimination systems. Everyone guaranteed minimum two scheduled matches.
- Youth and Masters divisions will be established by the tournament staff using a combination of age/weight factors to ensure most equitable possible pairings and upholding AAU guidelines that weight disparities seldom exceed 10% in any division whenever possible.
- Men and Women will use official AAU weight divisions listed on the entry form and must compete in the division corresponding to their actual body weight.
- Masters or youth ages 16 and older may also compete in the senior division if they choose or may enter both senior and their own, if they pay the added entry fee.
- Minimum age of 16 to enter senior division
- Slippers or shoes must be worn when off mat (AAU Clean Feet Rule).
- Any color uniform may be worn, but red uniform not permitted when on WHITE side of pairings.
