

EXPERIENCE LEVELS

Beginner: no more than 1 year (must wear WHITE belt in competition)
 Novice: 1 yr, less than 2 yrs (must wear GREEN belt in competition)
 Intermediate: 2 yrs, less than 4 yrs (must wear BROWN belt in competition)
 Advanced: 4 yrs + (must wear BLACK belt in competition)

Athletes will not be allowed to compete without appropriate belt color & official AAU karate patch sewn on Gi.
