Ohio AAU District Girls' Basketball Meeting Minutes Tuesday, November 9th, 2010

- Ohio AAU District Director Andy Fishman called the meeting (at Beavercreek High School) to order at 7:10pm after pizza
- o Attendees included Ohio AAU District Board Governor Mark Hecquet & Secretary Bill Kroth
- Other attendees included: Joe Fowler, Kelly McCormack, Amanda Walther, Dean Shields, Logan Allen, Leah Zimmerman, Steve Hutchinson, Anthony Clements, and Ed Carlin
- After a few welcoming remarks, Coach Fishman introduced Governor Hecquet who spoke about the emerging Ohio AAU
 District Grant Program (under development) which is intended to focus on 6 core Ohio Sports in order to drive more events & ultimately more membership
- Coach Fishman briefly overviewed the outcomes of the National AAU Convention in San Juan, Puerto Rico that occurred last week. Primary focus of the AAU Girls Basketball is to invest in events to drive membership & to give back to the Teams & Athletes to improve quality & experience. Coach Fishman applauded this direction & confirmed that the Executive Committee & the National Chair are holding the Ohio AAU accountable for Sanction Event increases & regulation of ODQT. Net, our goals are aligned.
- Coach Fishman discussed the new Ohio AAU Website, which is now managed by the National Office for the District. Content
 is a high priority for the Sports Directors.
- Coach Fishman reviewed Ohio AAU Girls Basketball data: Ohio has the 2nd largest Girls Basketball membership behind only Virginia & has grown 15% in the last year (2010 vs. 2009).
- o Plans include continued AAU member growth, DQT Teams, Nat. Championship Teams, & Super Regional Events.
- Coach Fishman offered an illustrative plan, which would grow the number of Ohio District Sanctioned events by +25% (12-15 more events in 2011). The present March-May 2011 list is as follows:
