- II. Officials Certification
 - a. There will be no certification classes held this season. Official's certification expires 2012.
 - 1. This will be a training year for anyone wanting to become an official.
 - 2. Mentors are needed.
 - b. Greg Johnson expressed "Thanks" to officials for such hard work.
 - c. Thanks to Mr. Boggs for doing such a great job as the Announcer and keeping the meets going smoothly.
 - d. Meet directors will work with Greg Johnson and Yolanda Freeman to recruit officials.
 - 1. Officials and Mr. Boggs will be paid \$30 per meet. That does not include the District meet or National Qualifier.
 - 2. Key to a successful meet
 - 1. Get started on time
 - 2. Have officials/coaches meeting
 - 3. Have volunteers
 - e. Judgment calls by Officials are not appealable.
 - f. Clinics are a useful tool to update and maintain skills.
 - 1. USATF Clinic January 29, 2012
 - 2. OATCCC Clinic January 27-28, 2012

- III. District & National Qualifier
 - a. The District meet location is set by the Ohio AAU T&F board.
 - b. The top 16 finishers in each event will advance to the National Qualifier.
 - c. An athlete may only advance to the National Qualifier in the event(s) in which he/she qualified at the district qualifier.
 - d. There will be no changes to results after 24 hour results submission period ends.
 - e. Any athlete scheduled to take SAT/ACT must request an exam waiver at <u>aauathleticswaiver@bellsouth.net</u>
 - f. New event Primary 1500 meter run
 - g. Pee Wee Division (5-6 yrs old)
 - 1. 100m
 - 2. 200m
 - 3. 400m
 - 4. Shot put (4lb.)
 - 5. Long jump
 - h. Turbo Jav will be coming along with short hurdles
- IV. National Qualifier
 - a. Anyone can bid for the NQ; they must complete the application and submit to National Headquarters with a non-refundable \$800 check
 - b. Major Changes
 - 1. Multi Schedule Thursday & Friday starts at 10am
 - 2. Track & Field starts Friday at 10:30am
 - 3. 200 meter qualifying races will be held on Friday evening starting at 6:00pm
 - 4. A review of the long jump and hurdles schedule was suggested
 - 5. If you miss the Ohio National Qualifier the only option is the Club Nationals in Orlando, FL
- V. AAU Scholarships Mrs. Boggs
 - a. Panel of judges are outside of the track and field world
 - b. Participants must have ran 1 season of AAU Track & Field during high school
 - c. Ohio AAU T&F association will give \$1000
 - d. Teams hosting a meet are being ask to give \$200, teams not hosting a meet are being ask to give \$100
 - e. Information will be going out in early May
- VI. Sanctions and Memberships
 - a. All sanctions must be approved by the District Chairman
 - b. All athletes and Coaches must have a current AAU membership
 - 1. PCA part 2 is available
- VII. BJT Timing & Medals
 - a. Contracts were passed out
 - 1. Discussion of new package and pricing.
 - b. Mistakes can be avoided if coaches, parents and athletes stay away from timing tent
 - c. All questions should be directed to the Meet Director
 - d. Any additions to be made after the close of registration will cost \$5 per athlete (if granted approval by Meet Director)
 - e. Bulk medals were a great success for the 2011 season. More information about bulk medals will be discussed during the 2012 Spring meeting

- VIII. Open Discussion
 - a. a shot put retrieval tube
 - b. during the National Qualifier in the clerking area there should be
 - 1. No Coaches
 - 2. No Parents
 - 3. No Sweats or Water bottles
 - 4. Athletes should come prepared to run
 - c. A suggestion that tents be donated for the National Qualifier so athletes don't sit in the sun.
 - d. Be sure that packets are complete at the Athlete's Only gate
 - 1. Wristbands are very important
 - e. A new process of writing down times athletes checked in during field events.
 - f. Strong interest in the Midwest Challenge meet to get a mixture of competition. Speak with other districts about participating.
 - g. During the National Qualifier the additional parking area is behind the tennis courts on Mitchell Blvd.
