

ALABAMA AAU BOY'S BASKETBALL 2010 CHECKLIST

1. **CLUB MEMBERSHIP MUST** be obtained either over the internet (<http://www.aausports.org>) or from Leora Washington, Southeastern Association Registration Chairperson as soon as possible. This fee is \$30.00 per club. Leora Washington can be reached at (800) 228-4872.
2. **ATHLETES AND COACHES' MEMBERSHIPS** Begin having your players and coaches complete the AAU Individual Membership Application form. You can send these forms to Leora Washington along with certified funds and she will return your AAU cards or you can register over the internet (<http://www.aausports.org>)/ **NOTE: Do not register over the internet until you have received your 2010 Club Number.** Also, to register by way of the internet you will need to use Visa, MasterCard, or Discover. All coaches, bench personnel, as well as players must be registered with AAU prior to play.

ALABAMA AAU BOYS' BASKETBALL 2010 MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION AND POLICIES

SEAAU will follow the policies outlined in the Boys' Basketball Handbook that the National AAU Boys' Basketball makes available to everyone through their website <http://www.aausports.org/>.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. Club registration is \$30.00 per team. You may obtain this by mailing a certified check or money order payable to Southeastern AAU or by way of the Internet (<http://www.aausports.org/>).
2. You must register your players and coaches with AAU. Cost: Athletes- - \$12.00 or Added Benefit \$14.00 and Coaches- - \$14.00 or Added Benefit \$16.00. Register easily through the AAU website (<http://www.aausports.org/>). **Registering through the website will save you substantial time. Your AAU cards can be printed immediately if you register on the web. The Internet saves you time and money.**

AGE REQUIREMENTS

(According to the 2010 AAU Boys' Basketball Handbook Eligibility Section)

This handbook can be accessed through the boys' basketball website at <http://www.aauboysbasketball.org/>.

1. **ELIGIBILITY**
 - A. AAU MEMBERSHIP.** All participants in the AAU Boy's Basketball program, at any level, must be a current member of AAU. Every club must have an AAU Club Membership for the current year.
 - B. AGE DETERMINING DATE.** September 1st, at 12:01 am., shall be the determining date for the age of the competitor and shall hold true for the Association and National Championships.
 - C. AGE DIVISIONS.** Competition in boys' basketball shall be in the following age divisions: 8-Under, 9-Under, 10-Under, 11-Under, 12-Under, 13-Under, 14-Under, 15-Under, 16-Under, 17-Under, 18-Under and high school age eligibility at the AAU Junior Olympic Games.
 - D. PLAYER PARTICIPATION.** Any player competing in a specific age division must remain in the same age division throughout the Association qualifying tournament and National level. **NOTE: A player may play in an older age division; i.e., a 13-year old could play in the 15-Under age division, but never a younger age division, such as a 15-year old playing in the 13-Under division.**
 - E. PARTICIPATION IN A BORDERING ASSOCIATION.** An athlete may participate in his own Association OR in a bordering Association but must register in his home Association. A maximum of three (3) athletes will be allowed on a team from bordering Associations.
