

Ozark AAU Officials Certification Clinic

Date: Friday April 4, 2014 and **Saturday April 5, 2014**

Registration: **Pre registration of application forms is required.** Payment can be made the day of the clinic, but forms must be submitted prior so the clinic cards can be prepared in advance and room size requirements can be determined. Forms can be downloaded from the AAU Taekwondo website by going to “Events → Official’s Clinics.” The form can be downloaded in both Excel and .PDF format. Excel formatted forms can be completed in Excel and emailed back. PDF forms can be mailed to me at 3666 Gail Dr., Imperial, MO. 63052.

Friday Time: 6:00 – 9:30 This is the PowerPoint portion of clinic. It is required to be certified.

Saturday Time: The 2nd half of the sparring clinic begins at 12:30 and will be the hands on, practical portion of the official’s clinic. Officials do not need to pay for the 2nd half of the clinic. Officials must take this portion of the clinic to be certified.

5. **If you have taken the online coaches clinic, there is no charge to attend this official’s clinic.**
