## **DIRECTIONS TO FITZGERALD GYM, QUEENS COLLEGE**

### FROM LONG ISLAND AND POINTS EAST

Take the L.I.E. westbound; watch for QC signs. Colden parking get off at Exit 23, turn left on the Main Street overpass. Turn left onto the service road of the LIE. Watch for QC signs to Colden parking on your right.

#### FROM MANHATTAN AND POINTS WEST

Take the L.I.E. Eastbound watch for QC signs. Colden parking, get off at Exit 23 stay on service road past Main Street. Watch for QC signs to Colden parking on your right.

### FROM SOUTHERN NEW JERSEY, STATEN ISLAND & BROOKLYN

Take the Verrazano Bridge into Brooklyn. Continue on I-278 to Exit 35E (I-495/L.I.E) Stay left, follow signs to Eastern Long Island. Colden parking, get off at exit 23 stay on service road past Main Street. Watch for QC signs to Colden parking on your right.

#### FROM NORTHERN NEW JERSEY

Take the G.W.B. (George Washington bridge) and stay straight on I-95N. Merge onto I-678 S via Exit 10 toward Whitestone Bridge (portion toll). Take the College Pt. Blvd exit 12A-toward I-495 E/L.I.E/Eastern L.I. Turn right onto College point Blvd. Turn left onto Horace Harding Expy S. Merge onto Long Island Expressway/I-495 E via the ramp on the left toward Eastern L.I. Colden parking, get off at Exit 23 stay on service road past Main Street. Watch for QC signs to Colden parking on your right.

## **FROM BRONX**

Merge onto I-678 via Exit 10 toward Whitestone Bridge (portion toll). Take the College Pt. Blvd exit 12A-toward I-495 E/L.I.E/Eastern L.I. Colden parking, get off at Exit 23 stay on service road past Main Street. Watch for QC signs to Colden parking on your right.
