If you plan to coach at all during this event, you must register and pay for coach's credentials.

Please Note: In order to coach this event, you must have been previously certified (in 2016 competition year) through our online certification course and be able to prove it! **This course may be accessed through our web site aautaekwondo.org. On home page, click on COACHING.**

All officials who wish to work the National Championship **MUST** be individual members of AAU and attend the national clinic.

ENTRY DEADLINE: All applications must be processed through our ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM located at <http://www.aautaekwondo.org> AND **completed** no **later than Monday, June 6th, 2016 @ 11:59 PM Eastern Standard Time.**

LATE FEES: Online registrations received between **Tuesday, June 7th and Thursday, June 9th** may still be accepted, **BUT will be assessed a \$75.00 Late Fee (no exceptions).**
There will be no refunds issued for any reason whatsoever.

INFO:**

Until your registration fee is actually paid; the individual athlete or coach IS NOT REGISTERED to participate. **All incomplete or unfinished registrations will be purged from the system on Thursday, June 9th at 11:59 PM**--the last day for Late Registrations. Regardless of when you actually begin the registration process, you must complete the transaction by the aforementioned deadline dates or late fees/disqualification will apply.

When completing your application, be sure to give the correct weight, and rank **as of the date(s) of competition**. It is your responsibility to insure that your weight matches the weight class you listed on your application--failure to make weight may result in your disqualification from sparring!

IF corrections to your application ARE accepted at check-in, a \$35.00 Change Order Fee will be assessed—CASH ONLY!

**AGE DETERMINING
DATE:**

Athletes shall be placed in the appropriate AGE category based on their age as of **December 31, 2016** (AAU Taekwondo's Age Determining Date). Cadet and Junior athletes MAY be required to show a **copy** of their birth certificate or passport at check-in. Please be sure to bring yours in order to avoid a potential disqualification.

**AAU NATIONAL
TEAM TRIAL**

Beginning with the selection of our 2013 Teams the selection methodology and financial support for the Senior and 12-14 year old Cadet Teams were flip-flopped.

The Senior Team shall be established at the National Championship by virtue of capturing the 1st Place Gold Medal in single elimination competition and the top four finishers in the 12-14 year old Black Belt divisions will be invited to Team Trials along with the current member of that team to compete under international rules (regarding a kick to the head) for the Team Member slot.

Correspondingly, Senior Team Members will be invited to train and travel with the National Teams at their own expense and the AAU Taekwondo Program now funds team travel for the 12-14 year Team.

The AAU has always been about Youth Sports (at least since the passage of the Sports Act which created the NGB's). These new policies better align the AAU Taekwondo Program with its parent organization's direction and more fairly allocate the resources we do have with those that provide those resources—our youngest members.

This information is provided here, in the National Championship Information Package, so that both our Senior and Cadet 'elite' athletes may make a better informed decision as to their participation.

For those Black Belts competing in the Olympic Sparring Divisions, everyone must compete in the age category befitting their age according to our Age Determining Date. **Fourteen year olds must compete as 12-14 year olds at the National Championship AND if you place in the top four spots you will be invited to the 12-14 year old Cadet Team Trials. Should you turn 14 in 2017 you will be invited to travel with the Junior Team.**

The same rule applies to 17 year olds. You will compete as a Junior and if you place in The top four you will be invited to Team Trials in September. Should you win you will be considered a member of Junior Team with financial support. If you turn 18 prior to

Team Travel you will simply be entered in the Senior Division at that event.

National Senior Team Members and the 10-11 Cadet Team members will be invited to the annual Team Training camp weekend and will receive a National Team Warm-up similar to that worn by our Junior and Cadet Team Members.

AAU MEMBERSHIP: All athletes, coaches, and officials **MUST** be individual members of the AAU and be prepared to present their membership card at the time of their check-in.

ELIGIBILITY: Qualification to the National AAU Taekwondo Championship must be determined by actual competition. Qualification may only be determined through:

- a) District Championship
- b) Regional Championship
- c) National Championship

District & Regional Championships	National Championship
These events may qualify the top eight (8) athletes from each appropriate age and division category to participate at the National Championship.	This event may qualify the Gold Medal athletes from the PRIOR year's national event.

RULES: The AAU Taekwondo Rules, as posted on the AAU Taekwondo Web Site, shall govern this event. All officials and coaches participating in the National Championship must have completed the 2016 AAU Certification process and be duly certified to perform same by the AAU Taekwondo Committee. All officials must also have in their possession the current rulebook. You may download these rules for FREE at www.aautaeqwondo.org.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS: All contestants must wear a clean **white** dobok only.
See AAU Taekwondo Rulebook.

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS: Please refer to the proper pages in the 2016 AAU Taekwondo Rulebook for the mandatory and optional equipment requirements for point sparring and Olympic style sparring respectively. No exceptions!
