All officials who wish to work the National Championship MUST be individual members of AAU and attend the national clinic.

All applications must be processed through our ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM located at <u>http://www.aautaekwondo.org</u> AND completed no later than Thursday, June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 11:59 PM Eastern Standard Time (EST).

Regardless of when you actually begin the registration<br/>process, you must complete the transaction by the aforementioned deadline dates or<br/>late fees/disqualification will apply.

When completing your application, be sure to give the correct weight, and rank **as of the date(s) of competition.** It is your responsibility to insure that your weight matches the weight class you listed on your application--failure to make weight may result in your disqualification from sparring!

IF corrections to your application ARE accepted at check-in, a \$40 Change Order Fee will be assessed—CASH ONLY!

- AGE DETERMININGAthletes shall be placed in the appropriate AGE category based on their age as ofDATE:December 31, 2019 (AAU Taekwondo's Age Determining Date). Cadet and Junior athletesMAY be required to show a copy of their birth certificate or passport at check-in. Please be<br/>sure to bring yours in order to avoid a potential disqualification.
- AAU TEAMS FOR OUR OLYMPIC SPARRING COMPETITORS: The Pre-Cadet (10-11) Teams shall be established at the National Championship by virtue of capturing the 1<sup>st</sup> Place Gold Medal in single elimination competition.

Pre-Cadet Team Members will be invited to train and travel with the National Teams at their own expense.

The top four finishers in the Cadet (12-14), Junior (15-17) and Senior (18-32) Black Belt divisions will be invited to Team Trials in August along with the current member of that team to compete under international rules (regarding a kick to the head) for the Team Member slot.

For those Black Belts competing in the Olympic Sparring Divisions, everyone must compete in the age category befitting their age according to our Age Determining Date. Fourteen year olds must compete as 12-14 year olds at the National Championship AND if you place in the top, four spots you will be invited to the 12-14-year-old Cadet Team Trials. Should you turn 15 in 2019 you will be invited to travel with the Junior Team at that time

**FOR OUR POINT SPARRING COMPETITORS:** All Point Sparring Teams shall be Determined at the National Championship by virtue of capturing the 1<sup>st</sup> Place Gold Medal in single elimination competition.

- **AAU MEMBERSHIP:** All athletes, coaches, and officials MUST be individual members of the AAU and be prepared to present their membership card at the time of their check-in.
- **ELIGIBILITY:** Qualification to the National AAU Taekwondo Championship must be determined by actual competition. Qualification may only be determined through:
  - a) District Championship
  - b) Regional Championship
  - c) National Championship

#### **District & Regional Championships**

These events may qualify the top eight (8) athletes from each appropriate age and division category to participate at the National Championship.

**RULES:** The AAU Taekwondo Rules, as posted on the AAU Taekwondo Web Site, shall govern this event. All officials and coaches participating in the National Championship must have completed the 2019 AAU Certification process and be duly certified to perform same by the AAU Taekwondo Committee. All officials must also have in their possession the current rulebook. You may download these rules FREE at www.aautaekwondo.org.

- This event will be offered for all ages
- This event will be offered for all belt levels
- Judging criteria includes Beauty, Grace, Rhythm, Focus, Power, & Technique

#### **Traditional Forms: TSD**

- Brazilian Repechage Format
- Allowed patterns are defined within pg 54 of AAU Taekwondo Handbook under TSD forms
- This event will be offered for all ages
- This event will be offered for all belt levels
- Judging criteria includes Beauty, Grace, Rhythm, Focus, Power, & Technique

#### **Traditional Forms: Open Traditional**

- Brazilian Repechage Format
- ITF, WT & TSD patterns will be allowed to compete together
- Allowed patterns are defined within pg 54 of AAU Taekwondo Handbook
- This event will be offered for all ages
- This event will be offered for all belt levels
- Judging criteria includes Beauty, Grace, Rhythm, Focus, Power, & Technique

### Tuesday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> continued

#### Weapons Forms: Traditional

- Brazilian Repechage Format
- No live blades will be allowed
- Minimum one hand must remain in contact with the weapon at all times
- Ground rolls are allowed
- Inverted aerial maneuvers are not allowed
- Weapons are subject to inspection by Chief Referee and may be prohibited if deemed unsafe
- Judging criteria includes Beauty, Grace, Rhythm, Focus, Power, & Technique
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#### Weapons Forms: Creative

- Brazilian Repechage Format
- No live blades will be allowed
- Weapon releases are allowed in creative division
- Inverted aerial maneuvers are allowed in creative division
- Weapons are subject to inspection by Chief Referee and may be prohibited if deemed unsafe
- Judging criteria includes Beauty, Grace, Rhythm, Focus, Power, Technique & Creativity

### Wednesday July 3rd

#### **ALL Special Needs Divisions:**

• All special needs board breaking divisions shall compete on Wednesday July 3

#### **Board Breaking: Open Breaking**

- Brazilian Repechage Format
- Athletes compete in a side-by-side manor (superior technique advances to the next round)
- 90 seconds maximum setup/break time allowed per competitor
- Maximum of 10 boards utilized is allowed per competitor, per round of competition
- No forehead breaking, open flames, or bladed props may be used
- No jumping/flying over people will be allowed
- No spacers will be allowed
- No direct elbow strikes will be allowed
- Athlete technique will be judged based on the following criteria
  - o Technique, focus, balance, power, and creativity
    - For two competitors executing the same technique as part of competition:
      - A break performed on the 1st try is superior to a break completed on the 2nd try
      - A two board break is superior to a one board break; a three board break is superior to a two board break
      - A break supported on one end (speed break) is superior to a break supported on both ends (for same number of boards)

#### **Board Breaking: Repetitive Spin Hook**

- Single break format
- Allowed technique is spinning hook kick
- Maximum number of boards broken within 20 seconds wins

• One board per strike

# Wednesday July 3<sup>rd</sup> continued

#### **Board Breaking: Repetitive Side Kick**

- Single break format
- Allowed technique is side kick
- Maximum number of boards broken within 20 seconds wins
- One board per strike

#### **Board Breaking: Repetitive Hand Technique**

- Single break format
- Allowed technique is hammer fist, palm, knife or fist (punch)
- Maximum number of boards broken within 20 seconds wins
- One board per strike

#### **Demo Team Competition**

- Three to twenty member teams (any rank)
- All members & volunteers must be current AAU members
- Four-minute demonstration time limit
- All technical Taekwondo skills are graded for execution, presentation and difficulty
- Teams are granted freedom to add creativity to their demonstration, however synchronization may or may not be part of the team demonstration
- All props are subject to inspection of Chief Referee, and may be prohibited if deemed unsafe

#### National Dan Testing (3<sup>rd</sup> Dan & higher)

On the evening of Wednesday July 3<sup>rd</sup> from 5 to 8pm, a National AAU Taekwondo Dan testing will be held for 3<sup>rd</sup> Dan and higher ranks. This prestigious opportunity is offered to all AAU Taekwondo members, the testing will allow for testing in any accepted style (ITF, WT, TSD).
