The top 8 athletes in each division will be qualified for this year's AAU Taekwondo National Championships, held in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Our event was a huge success in 2024, and we thank the Taekwondo community last year for joining us. This year, we will be bringing the competitions back to the metropolitan area due to popular demand.

This year, we have added Traditional Point Sparring, Sport Poomsae (Black Belts Only), Sport Poomsae Pairs (Black Belts Only), Sport Poomsae Team (Black Belts Only), Para Division Forms & Open Board Breaking to our event. We will be using the full venue, 10 Olympic size rings. There will be special recognition awards for top clubs, athletes, coaches and referees.

Please review the enclosed material, complete all necessary paperwork online. There is no door or paper registration. The more participants who pre-register early, the smoother and more economical the process will be. Please keep in mind that no tournament day registration will be permitted in order to ensure an orderly and timely progression of events on the tournament day. All registration should be completed online at tourneyreg.net. If anyone needs help, I or my staff will personally assist you in registering.

We will be using the DAEDO PSS system for Olympic Sparring divisions Red Belt and above. We will have socks available at the venue to purchase.

Medals are awarded for the top four finishers in each division and all participants will receive a certificate for participation. Enclosed you will find a tournament poster to display in your school.

Best of 3 Format: Three 60 Seconds Rounds, First to 2 Wins

12 Point Gap ALL Rounds

Junior Safety Rules (Light Head Contact)

COACH APPEAL: limited to 1 action which occurred within 5 seconds of the appeal

Non IVR – 2 Cards | Coach may appeal for the following:

Technical points for turning kicks

Head or face kicks unscored

Wrong identification of punch point by judges

Invalidation of point(s) after gam-jeom was given for prohibited act.

Error in Time Management

Mechanical Malfunction (Hogu/Gear Test) - Coach may use challenge card to request testing of the PSS system any time during the 2nd and/or 3rd round. If PSS works properly, the coach shall lose the challenge card and the player will receive a gam-jeom. Referee shall use his challenge card to test PSS equipment during 1st RD.

TRADITIONAL POINT SPARRING:

One 2 Minute Round, 7 Point Gap, Golden Round for Tie (Must win by a 2-point net change in the score) Each coach allowed one 10 second time out for each match that can be used only during a break in the action to call points for either player. Coaches cannot call time during active match play.

Penalties – a total of four (4) total point in penalties will disqualify that competitor

WT FORMS: BRACKETED

Novice, Intermediate, Advanced: May do any form listed for any of their previous ranks as well as current rank. 1st Dan competitors may do any form/pattern listed for Advanced or 1st Dan Ranks

2nd Dan+ competitors may do any for/pattern listed for any dan rank up to and including their current rank.

WT Sport Poomsae Standards are NOT utilized for scoring for these events.

OPEN FORMS: BRACKETED

May do any form listed in their rank level for ITF, TSD/MDK form/pattern. Check above diagram. *WT Forms will not be allowed in this event.*

SPORT POOMSAE: POOMSAE PRO ELECTRONIC

Sport poomsae will be for BLACK BELTS only. Color belts may enroll in WT FORMS.

Designated poomsae will be posted 3 weeks prior to the competition date.

CREATIVE WEAPONS FORMS: BRACKETED

Single elimination, 90 Second Time Limit, No Music

No live blades allowed. Weapons are subject to inspection by Chief Referee.

Approved Weapons: Kamas, Sword, Tonfa, Staff, Nunchaku, Knife, Polearm, Eku, Cane, Fan, Escrima

Judging Criteria: Creativity, Technique, Power Focus, Rhythm, Grace, Beauty

Allow contemporary martial arts technique either added to a traditional form or a form devised by the competitor. Form must include the majority of techniques which originate from martial arts (Gymnastics motions allowed but form must remain primarily martial arts based)

Form must include spinning kicks, jump spinning kicks, multiple kicks and splits. No obstacles or props.

Competitors may not switch weapons during weapons forms.

OPEN BOARD BREAKING: NUMBER SCORING

Boards MUST be purchased onsite and sold in stacks of 10. Any form of board tampering will lead to disqualification. Number scoring format

90 seconds maximum setup/break time allowed per competitor

Maximum of 10 boards per competitor

No forehead breaking, open flames, or bladed props may be used

No jumping/flying over people will be allowed

No spacers will be allowed

No direct elbow strikes will be allowed.

Athlete technique will be judged based on the following criteria: Technique, focus, balance, power and creativity
