KP & P Update

It has recently come to my attention that Vision USA had posted the following message on its web site concerning the new (Version 2.0) KP&P sock.

IMPORTANT UPDATE

Sensitivity level got doubled with two additional sensor chips. Now there are total four sensor chips to make your game more accurate and fair. **All AAU competitors** for upcoming Nationals must wear the version 2.0 to avoid any potential disadvantage.

This notice is 100% incorrect and misleading! It is our opinion and the opinion of those we have questioned regarding the new sock, that YES, if the event is featuring the new KP&P E-Headgear then this new sock with the additional sensors should seriously be considered.

However, as long as we are NOT using the E-Headgear then the older version KP&P sock will certainly suffice. You may choose to purchase the new sock if you so like or to provide yourself with some additional peace of mind. But **AAU competitors are NOT being required to make this purchase. It is entirely up to you.**

Additionally, I am told by Vision that they will no longer carry the Version 1.0 sock. I have been told that other KP&P distributers, such as Dynamics on the East Coast and Masterline on the West Coast both carry and can supply Version 1.0 if you wish to make such a purchase. The **CHOICE** is entirely yours.
