FORMAT: Competition will be held in a pool play format with all teams advancing to a championship or

consolation bracket. Competition will begin at 9:00 am each day and run through the

evening. The format of the tournament and the start time is subject to change.

with your membership number. You will need your membership number to sign-up for
the AAU Junior Olympic Games.

and Discover are accepted.
