Greg Wojciechowski produced an outstanding wrestling career as a two time Ohio high school state champion (single division), a three time NCAA finalist and one time NCAA champion, a thirteen time national champion in the Olympic styles, a two time Pre-Olympic games medalist, a two time World Cup Freestyle medalist, a two time top six place winner in the World freestyle championships, and a member of the US Olympic Freestyle team.

Wojciechowski followed up his amateur achievements with a successful professional wrestling career while teaching at Libbey high school in Toledo. He also contributed to the accomplishments of Northwest Ohio wrestling by coaching at Archibold High School, Libbey High School several times, and Bowsher High School. At programs where he often had to revitalize a declining program, he produced one state champion at Archibold, one state runner-up at Libbey, a three time state qualifier at Libbey, and several times had multiple state qualifiers in the same year at Bowsher.
