

Blair Brown was the Honda Award Winner for volleyball. She made the AVCA First Team All-American, the AVCA All-Mideast Region and the NCAA Championship All-Tournament Team. Brown was honored with the University Park Regional Most Outstanding Player, the Unanimous First Team All-Big Ten, the Big Ten Player of the Year and three-time Big Ten Player of the Week. This outstanding volleyball player from Penn State was named to the Nike Big Four Volleyball Classic All-Tournament Team, the Hampton Inn Classic All-Tournament Team and was honored as the Carolina Classic MVP. She was a unanimous Preseason All-Big Ten player and guided the Nittany Lions to a four consecutive National Championship title. Brown led the Nittany Lions in kills with 521, averaging 4.24 kills per set; this also ranked 21st in the nation and second in the Big Ten. Blair's 4.72 points per set ranked 18th in the nation. Blair was second on the team with 113 blocks and 281 digs. She started all 37 matches in 2010 and surpassing the 1,000 career kills milestone this past year, closing out her career with 1,295 kills.

Blair has volunteered at the Centre County Special Olympics as well as the Penn State Dance Marathon. Over the summers, she has worked at volleyball camps at Penn State University and Juniata.
