

Robert Hoadley, an outstanding golfer graduated from Union Pines High School in 2008. He was the conference player of the year in 2007 and 2008. Hoadley was named North Carolina Junior Champion in 2008 and honored to join the North Carolina Junior Team in 2006 and 2007. He made the North Carolina All State team in 2008. Robert was named the 2008-2009 Male Athlete of the Year for Union Pines High School. As a freshman in college at UNCG, he became the 2010 Southern Conference All Freshman player of the year and named to the All-Freshman team. Hoadley ranked 180 out of 600 in NCAA.

In high school Robert was a member of the National Honor Society, the Key Club and the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. He graduated 18th in his class with a GPA of 4.5. In 2008-2009, he won the United States Army Reserve National Scholar/Athlete Award. At UNCG, he made the Athletic Director Honor Roll in the fall of 2009, spring 2010 and fall 2010. This bright young athlete was named Southern Conference All Academic for 2009-2010 with a GPA of 3.36.

Robert was a participant of The First Tee of the Sandhills from 2003-2009. During that time he also acted as a mentor to the younger members. He has spoken at Rotary Club meetings about his involvement with the First Tee. Since being at UNC-Greensboro he has continued to volunteer time to The First Tee of the Triad, 2009-2011.
