Host AAU Qualifying Tournaments

- **AAU Baseball Super Regional**
Top four teams from each age division will qualify for the AAU Nationals with the top team winning a free entry into the AAU National Championships.
- **AAU National Championship Series**
All teams that participate in the National Championship Series will qualify for the AAU Grand Nationals and the top two teams will get a free entry into the AAU National Championships.
- **State Championships**
Top eight teams will qualify for the AAU Nationals in each age division with Championship team receiving a free entry into the AAU National Championships.
- **National AAU Travel Baseball League**
Each age division's champion will receive a free entry into the AAU National Championships. All teams that participate in the AAU Travel League will have the right to attend the AAU National Championships.

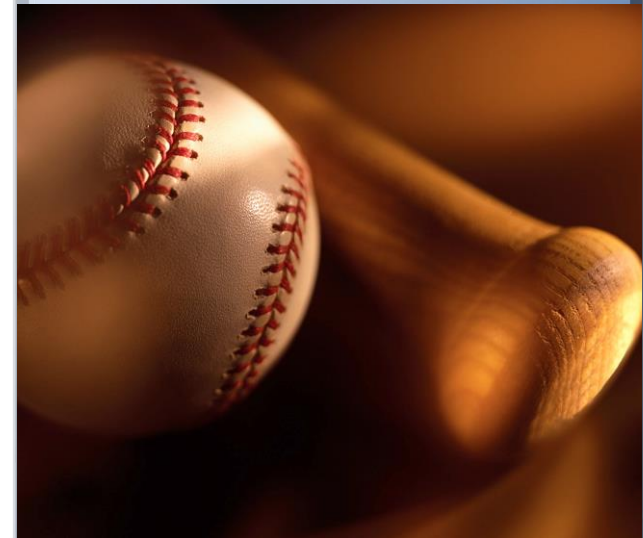

Earn More Money!!!

Did you know AAU doesn't charge you a per-team fee for your event?

You keep all the money you earn...

- Example: If you host a tournament with 32 teams, you pay your operational expenses and you keep all the rest. With AAU you DON'T send \$40 a team to the national organization or the state director. That puts \$1280 back into your pocket per event.

What will AAU do for you??

- AAU Baseball will pay ALL AAU licensing fees for new operators' events for the first two (2) years.
- FREE insurance certificates for 200 facilities or fields for new operators for your first two (2) years.
- FREE AAU Club Level 2 membership for new operators. AAU Baseball will supply each new tournament host with a FREE club level 2 membership for his/her first two (2) years.
- AAU will advertise all operators' events on the AAU Baseball website, through eblasts, and newsletter highlights AT NO CHARGE to YOU.
- All operators will be covered with a generous comprehensive liability policy at NO EXTRA CHARGE.
- Provide one of the best National Championships in the country for teams you qualify - always.



National AAU Rebate Program

AAU Baseball will rebate each tournament host \$25.00 for every team from their licensed qualifier that they send to the AAU Nationals, Grand Nationals or Junior Olympic Games.

- Example: you send 15 teams to any AAU Nationals or JOs from your licensed qualifier and receive \$375.00 in rebates

National AAU Bonus Program

New operators, for the first 1,000 members that join your AAU club, you will receive a \$500.00 bonus. For every 1,000 members after that, you'll receive an additional \$200.00. When your club membership reaches 5,000 members, you'll receive \$1,000.00! Once you are an established operator with more than 1,000 members as of the previous membership year, the above formula will apply for new members over and above 90% of your prior year's membership.

Things You Should Know

- AAU license gives each tournament host \$10M in liability coverage.
- AAU Non-Athlete/Coaches memberships include background checks at no additional fee.
- AAU Athlete memberships have full insurance coverage at no extra charge.
- Only \$200.00 deductible when there is no other insurance coverage.
- Usually no deductible if there is primary accident insurance.
- AAU Membership is valid from September 1 thru August 31.
- One AAU Membership is valid for ALL AAU's 35 sports.

The BIG Question

Do YOU need to register the teams to play AAU?

“NO”

Here is what you need to do as a tournament director.

Inform coaches to notify their parents to go to www.aubaseball.org and obtain an AAU membership. Once the athlete has his membership, he can play on any AAU team in your events. Require proof of membership before your event. The coach **NEVER** has to do anything other than check that each of his players and coaches have their membership. Give the coaches your club code so that the parent can enter this code on the player's registration. This is how you will get the credit for the membership in your **BONUS** program!!
