Membership Year

September 1st - August 31st is the fiscal year and the membership year for the Amateur Athletic Union.

AAU Definitions

The following definitions will be applied to all athletes, coaches, and member clubs:

PRACTICE: For the purpose of AAU sanctioning, “practice is organized and/or regularly scheduled sessions supervised at all times by a registered AAU coach or instructor and conducted for the purpose of preparing, training, instructing, and conditioning only AAU registered athletes for AAU competitions.” Tryouts and scrimmages are included as long as they meet all the requirements of the above definition.

SUPERVISION: Supervision requires that an AAU registered coach/instructor be physically present at all times at the practice premises or site during each practice session.

SCRIMMAGE: A practice of an AAU club with another AAU club or with AAU athletes or another AAU club. A scrimmage does not qualify as practice if it is open to the public, an admission fee is charged, or the officials are paid. Scrimmage results must not affect the club’s standing or rankings.
