AGE DIVISIONS: Under 5 – Under 19

QUALIFICATION: This is an open event no pre-qualification is required

ENTRY FEE: \$200.00 per team. Entry fees are non-refundable.

HOUSING:

In addition to registering with Kick It 3v3 Soccer, all athletes must register for an AAU Membership at www.aaujrogames.org.

Step 1: Become a member of AAU at www.aausports.org. Click on Join AAU and select Athlete Membership. Follow the registration steps online. Once you have your AAU membership

number, proceed to Step 2. If you have a valid AAU membership for 2014 (for any sport), skip this step.

AWARDS: AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be awarded to all members of the top three (3) teams.

CHECK-IN: Prior to competition, teams must check-in at the lowa Events Center located at 730 3rd Street, Des

Moines, IA 50309 to receive their athlete credential or coach wristband. The appropriate credential or wristband will be needed prior to gaining admittance into the competition venues. Participants should check-in at least the day prior to competing. If that credential or wristband is lost or stolen there will be a replacement fee. Parking fees do apply for the lots around the lowa Events Center. For check-in hours,

REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS:

All teams qualify for the Open Division by participating in this event. Divisions are formed based off rankings and record. Gold, Silver and Bronze divisions are formed.

USA 3v3 CHAMPIONSHIPS:

Teams that participate in this event qualify for the OPEN division. The top 2 teams in each division at any Kick It 3v3 Regional Championships will qualify for EID at the USA 3v3 National Championships.

DISNEY 3v3 Soccer Championships:

Teams that participate in this event qualify for the OPEN division at the Disney 3v3 Soccer Championships at the ESPN Wide World of Sports near Orlando, FL. Teams must play and finish in the top 6 of their age group at a Kick It 3v3 Regional Championship to qualify for the Invitational division at the Disney 3v3 Soccer Championships.

ELITE INVITATIONAL DIVISION (E.I.D.):

Kick It's ELITE INVITATIONAL DIVISION is designed for qualified teams that have participated and placed at high level events like the Kick It World Championships, National Invitational, and EID Super Regionals. In an effort to accommodate all player and team skills the Elite Invitational Division will separate and qualify teams under strict guidelines. Qualification requirements for the E.I.D. are very strict. Only the best of the best 3v3 soccer teams are invited:

Top 2 teams in the gold division from each Kick It 3v3 Regional Championship Top 4 teams in each division from Kick It 3v3 National Invitational Tournament
