AGE DIVISIONS: Boys 11U Championship – athletes born on or after May 1, 2003

Boys 12U Championship – athletes born on or after May 1, 2002

QUALIFICATION: This is an open event. No pre-qualification is required.

AAU MEMBERSHIP: All clubs, athletes, bench personnel (coaches/scorekeeper) and bat persons must be current

members of the AAU. Club membership starts at \$30. Individual membership is \$14 per youth athlete and \$16 per non-athlete (coach, scorekeeper, team representative). The cost of membership

is in addition to the entry fee. To become a member, join online at www.aausports.org.

You can no longer register for non-athlete (coach) membership onsite. Background screens are conducted for all non-athletes and adult athletes. Membership is no longer instant. BE

PREPARED and register your coaches early!

ENTRY FEE: \$595 per team. Entry fees are non-refundable.

STEP 2 - Complete your team roster online. THIS STEP IS REQUIRED.

Rosters including all athletes, bench personnel (coaches/scorekeeper), bat persons and team administrator must be submitted online. This is required. You can make changes to your roster at Team Check-In; however any additions must have a current AAU membership. You can

no longer register for membership onsite.

Each team will consist of up to 20 players, 4 bench personnel (coaches/scorekeeper), 2 bat-

persons and 1 team administrator.

HOUSING: The AAU makes every effort to provide the best quality experience for athletes, coaches and

RULES OF PLAY:

Unless otherwise stated in this handbook the rules of competition shall be those of Major League Baseball (American League Rules) except where amended by AAU Baseball. Only those rules contained in this handbook shall supersede the general rules of the national governing body.

Note that coaches are responsible to familiarize themselves with all AAU rules and policies as described in the full AAU Baseball Handbook and not just those playing rules highlighted in the abbreviated rules.

AWARDS:

AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be awarded to the members of the top three (3) teams.

TEAM CHECK-IN:

A team representative must check-in the team on July 30, 2015 at Boo Williams Sportsplex. At check-in, athlete credentials and bench personnel wristbands will be distributed. The appropriate credential or wristband will be needed prior to gaining admittance into the competition venues. There is a replacement fee for lost credentials or wristbands. COACHES MEETING:

A coaches meeting will take place on July 30, 2015. The location and time of the meeting will be announced after the entry deadline.

CELEBRATION OF ATHLETES:

The Celebration of Athletes will be held on August 3, 2015 at Norfolk State University. You won't want to miss this year's Celebration! More information will be posted at www.aaujrogames.org as it becomes available.

TRANSPORTATION:

Participants and spectators are responsible for their own transportation to and from all activities, events, and hotels.

PARKING:

Please note that you must check-in and pick up your credential prior to receiving admittance into any venue, including the Celebration of Athletes. You must have the appropriate wristband or credential.

Spectators can purchase tickets onsite at the venues. Daily passes are \$12.00 (6 & under free) and includes admission to all competition venues on the designated day only. Event passports are \$40.00 (6 & under free). For more information on ticket options, please visit www.aaujrogames.org.
