- QUALIFICATION:** All athletes eligible to compete will have been selected from the USA Field Hockey Futures Program. For more information, visit www.usafieldhockey.com.
- AAU MEMBERSHIP:** All participants must be members of the AAU which is \$14 per athlete. Visit www.aausports.org and click on Join Now to become a member of the AAU.
- ENTRY FEE:** \$48.00 per athlete. Entry fees are non-refundable.
- ONLINE REGISTRATION & ENTRY DEADLINE:** In addition to registering with USAFH, all athletes must register with AAU online at www.aaujrogames.org. Entries must be completed online by **Wednesday, July 15, 2015**. Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover is accepted.

AWARDS:	AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be awarded to all members of the top three (3) teams.
ATHLETE CHECK-IN:	<u>Athletes must check-in before being allowed to practice or compete.</u> Field Hockey participants must check-in at the Virginia Beach Convention Center located at 1000 19 th Street, Virginia Beach, VA 23451 to receive their athlete credential or coach wristband. The appropriate credential or wristband will be needed prior to gaining admittance into the competition venues. Participants should check-in at least the day prior to competing. <i>If that credential or wristband is lost or stolen there will be a replacement fee.</i> For check-in hours, maps and additional directions please visit www.aaujrogames.org (click on Event Info, then Registration).
CELEBRATION OF ATHLETES:	The Celebration of Athletes will be held on August 3, 2015 at Norfolk State University. You won't want to miss this year's Celebration! More information will be posted at www.aaujrogames.org as it becomes available.
