Senior Advanced. Two divisions per age group (male and female) and category will be featured. However, each age division may be further sub-divided according to height and/or weight as deemed

necessary by the National AAU Kung-Fu Committee.

AAU MEMBERSHIP: All athletes and coaches must be members of their AAU District. Athlete membership is \$14 and non-

athlete (coach) membership is \$16. To become an AAU member, join online at www.aausports.org.

BE PREPARED and register your coaches early! You can no longer register for non-athlete (coach) membership onsite at the event. New this year, background screens are conducted for

all non-athletes and adult athletes. Membership is no longer instant.

In order to complete your registration to participate in the 2015 AAU Junior Olympic Games, you are required to use hotel accommodations as advertised at www.aaujrogames.org. If your team or athlete is local or not planning to stay at one of the recommended properties, you can submit a Housing Form available online at www.aaujrogames.org.

RULES: AAU Kung-Fu rules.

AWARDS: AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be awarded to the top three (3) places in each division and

discipline for the competition; AAU Junior Olympic Games ribbons will be awarded 4th - 8th place.

UNIFORMS: Clean, Chinese style uniform is mandatory. NO school or club logos on the uniform. Sparring

competitors may wear an AAU t-shirt and workout shorts; shirts with school logo not permitted.

CAUTIONS: The following items may not be worn during competition: headbands, jewelry, and metal hair clips.

Fingernails should be cut short. Bandages and/or any wraps must be approved by the sports medicine staff on site prior to competition. Regular plastic eyeglasses may not be worn during fighting

competition. School logos on uniform are not permitted.

MANDATORY EQUIPMENT: AAU National Kung-Fu Committee approved equipment only. No competitor will be allowed to compete

without proper uniform and mandatory equipment. Mandatory for Sparring competitors: Foam dipped

headgear with mask, mouth guards, cups for all males, foam dipped fist guards.

OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT: Shin and instep guard (white cotton type only), chest protectors, certified prescription safety glasses

with strap.

COACHES: Coaches must register online at www.aaujrogames.org and pay the \$40 coaches' entry fee. Coaches

must have a non-athlete AAU membership and will need their number to register online for the event. If a coach brings ten (10) athletes, the coaches' fee will be paid for by AAU Kung-Fu. A late fee of \$10 will be charged for any onsite coaches entries. BE PREPARED and register your coaches early! New this year, background screens are conducted for all non-athletes and adult athletes.

Membership is no longer instant.

ALL COACHES MUST WEAR BLACK PANTS AND A RED POLO TO BE ALLOWED ON THE

COMPETITION FLOOR.

COACHES AND OFFICIALS MUST ATTEND A MANDAROTY MEETING THAT WILL TAKE PLACE

ON THE COMPETITION FLOOR PRIOR TO THE START OF COMPETITION.

Coaches must be properly attired according to AAU Kung-Fu Rules. Only proper attire as deemed by

the National AAU Executive Committee will be acceptable.

COACHES' EDUCATION: The AAU is happy to make available **FREE Coaches' Education** for all AAU non-athlete members.

This excellent program is **MANDATORY** for all AAU non-athletes and will be administered by Positive Coaching Alliance (PCA). Please visit www.aausports.org and click on PCA COACHES EDUCATION order to enter and take the MANDATORY AAU/PCA coaches educational course. Membership may be

revoked from non-athletes who do not complete course prior to competition.

QUALIFICATION: This is an open qualification event; you do not need to qualify to enter and participate in the AAU Junior

Olympic Games Kung-Fu.

ATHLETE CHECK-IN: Kung Fu participants must check-in at the Virginia Beach Convention Center located at 1000 19th Street,

Virginia Beach, VA 23451 to receive their athlete credential or coach wristband. The appropriate credential or wristband will be needed prior to gaining admittance into the competition venues. Participants should check-in at least the day prior to competing. If that credential or wristband is lost or stolen there will be a replacement fee. Athletes and coaches with a credential will receive admission to all competition venues and the Celebration of Athletes as part of your entry fee. Please note that you must check-in and pick up your credential prior to receiving admittance into any venue, including the Celebration of Athletes. You must have the appropriate wristband or credential.

Spectators can purchase tickets onsite at the venues. Daily passes are \$12.00 (6 & under free) and includes admission to all competition venues on the designated day only. Event passports are \$40.00 (6 & under free). For more information on ticket options, please visit www.aaujrogames.org.
