QUALIFICATION:	This is an open event. No pre-qualification is required.			
DIVISIONS:	Team, Pom Squad, Stunt Team, Crowd Leader, Solo Cheer, Jump, Tumble Pass Levels 1-5 Small Team, Medium Team, Large Team Tiny (5 & under), Mini (8 & under), Youth (11 & under), Junior (14 & under), Senior (10-18 yrs old). AAU Cheerleading follows the US All Star Federation (USASF) age grid.			
RULES:	AAU Cheerleading follows the US All Star Federation (USASF) rules for the 2015-2016 cheerleading season, as modified by AAU Cheerleading. For all Pom Squad, Tumble, Cheer Solo, Crowd Leader, Jumps and Stunt Teams, the competitions will follow the rules posted on the web site at <u>www.aaucheerleading.org</u> (click on Rules).			
AGE DETERMINATION:	Divisions will be determined by the athlete's age as of August 31, 2015.			
AAU MEMBERSHIP:	All athletes and coaches must be members of the AAU and be able to present their 2016 AAU membership is of \$14.00 per youth athlete and \$16.00 per c athlete). COACHES & OFFICIALS:	: All coaches must be registered members of the AAU. Participating officials qualify for certification and ranking.			
COACHES' EDUCATION:	The AAU is happy to make available <b>FREE Coaches' Education</b> for all AAU non-athlete members. This excellent program is <b>MANDATORY</b> for all AAU non-athletes and will be administered by Positive Coaching Alliance (PCA). Please visit <u>www.aausports.org</u> and click on PCA COACHES EDUCATION order to enter and take the MANDATORY AAU/PCA coaches educational course. Membership may be revoked from non-athletes who do not complete course prior to competition.			
AWARDS:	Medals will be awarded to each participant, 100% placement. Grand Champion overall trophy. All participants will receive a T-shirt and participation certificate commemorating the event. Technical Committee may change awards given.			
EQUIPMENT:	<b>Sound Equipment</b> : Sound equipment will be provided. Each individual or team is responsible for providing their accompaniment to the Sound Manager on CD. The accompaniment must be the only sound on the CD and must be recorded at the very beginning of the CD. CD's should be clearly marked with the competitor's team name. The accompaniment must be recorded at the flat line of the equalizer to assure comparable volume for all teams. No volume adjustments will be made. The volume and quality of the accompaniment are the responsibility of the competitor and not the Sound Manager. Volume or quality of sound will not be judged. Coach or designated person will press button to start and stop music. Voice-overs on the CD's for the purpose of increasing the volume of cheers or chants are prohibited. Auxiliary input/iPod connections will also be available as well.			

Warm-up: Warm up will consist of 42 by 42 foam cheer floor as well as a stretch and tumble strip.

Competition: Competition will consist of a 42 by 42 spring floor.

CHECK-IN: Pre-Registration: It is extremely important that all entries be <u>received</u> no later than the entry deadline date. ENTRY FORM (S) RECEIVED BEYOND THAT DATE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED! Of course, we want as many athletes as possible to participate, so please get all entry forms in on time. Again, guaranteed overnight delivery will become mandatory if it is the only way to ensure compliance with the deadline date.

**Onsite Check-In:** Cheerleading participants must check-in to receive their athlete credential or coach wristband at the George R. Brown Convention Center. The appropriate credential or wristband will be needed prior to gaining admittance into the competition venues.
