AWARDS: AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be awarded to all members of the top three (3) teams.

ATHLETE CHECK-IN:

Athletes must check-in before being allowed to practice or compete. Field Hockey participants must check-in at the Suburban Collection Showplace, 46100 Grand River Rd., Novi, MI 48374 to receive their athlete credential or coach wristband. The appropriate credential or wristband will be needed prior to gaining admittance into the competition venues. Participants should check-in at least the day prior to competing. If that credential or wristband is lost or stolen there will be a replacement fee.
