

# 2020 AAU JUNIOR OLYMPIC GAMES - SWIMMING SHORT COURSE FESTIVAL



### **Meet Information Letter (Last Revised 7/09/20)**

#### TYPE OF MEET:

This is a three (3) day timed finals short course meet.

The event will be held at Cocoa Beach Aquatic Center. The number of onsite participants and spectators will be dictated by local COVID-19 restrictions at the time of the event.

**LICENSED BY:** The Amateur Athletic Union of the United States, Inc. (AAU)

#### **DATES & TIMES:**

30 – August 1 at Cocoa Beach (Short Course)

All AM 13&O Sessions Warm-up 7:30am; sessions start at 8:30am.

All PM 12&U Sessions Warm-ups 30 minutes guaranteed after sessions end, not before 11:00am

#### LOCATION:

Short Course - Cocoa Beach Aquatic Center, 4800 Tom Warriner Blvd., Cocoa Beach, FL 32931 One 25 yard course of 8 lanes & a warm-up and warm down area

#### TIMING SYSTEM:

Electronic timing system with manual backup

#### **MANDATORY COACHES MEETINGS:**

All coaches wanting Deck Access are expected to attend both meetings

#### **ELIGIBILITY**:

Open to all AAU registered athletes. If your swimmers are not yet members of the AAU:

#### **CREDENTIALS:**

A coach's pass allows admission into any of the venues for the AAU Junior Olympic Games. All coaches must be non-athlete members of the AAU. <u>Only coaches meeting the certification requirements below</u> will be eligible to receive credentials allowing access to the deck.

**BE PREPARED! -** Register your coaches early! You can no longer register for non-athlete (coach) membership onsite. Background screens are conducted for all non-athletes and adult athletes.

#### Coaches' certification requirements are as follows:

- 1. Current certification in CPR and First Aid, and
- 2. American Red Cross Coaches Safety Training and First Aid, American Red Cross, or YMCA Lifeguard Training.

#### OR

3. Valid USA Swimming Coach's Card.

Swimmers with no certified coach will be assigned to another team for practice and warm-up.

#### Deck Access Coaches' Credentials will be provided to teams as follows:

1 – 5	Swimmers Entered	1 Coach
6 – 10	Swimmers Entered	2 Coaches
11 – 20	Swimmers Entered	3 Coaches
21 & Above	Swimmers Entered	4 Coaches

<sup>\*</sup>Deck access credentials will be given at the coaches meeting. A check-in is required at both facilities.

#### **COACHES EDUCATION:**

The AAU is happy to make available **FREE Coaches' Education** for all AAU non-athlete members. This excellent program is **MANDATORY** for all AAU non-athletes and will be administered by Positive Coaching Alliance (PCA). Please visit <u>www.aausports.org</u> and click on PCA COACHES EDUCATION order to enter and take the MANDATORY AAU/PCA coaches educational course. Membership may be revoked from non-athletes who do not complete the course prior to competition.

#### **DECK PERSONNEL:**

Only registered and current coaches, athletes, officials and meet personnel are allowed on the deck or in locker rooms. All access points to the pool deck and locker rooms will either be secured or staffed by a meet worker checking credentials throughout the duration of the meet.

#### **HOUSING:**

The AAU makes every effort to provide the best quality experience for athletes, coaches and families that participate in AAU events. Athletes, coaches and families can choose from a wide variety of accommodations in various price points and with several levels of amenities. The local host clubs have carefully selected host hotels for participants with the lowest rates available. #### PRACTICE:

#### TRANSPORTATION:

All participants and spectators are responsible for their own transportation to and from all activities, events, and hotels.

#### **PARKING:**

Some locations may have parking fees. Please visit <u>www.aaujrogames.org</u> and click on Maps & Directions for more information. Also, some hotels may charge for parking. Please check with your hotel for specific information as prices vary.

Cocoa Beach Aquatic Center will have drop off and pick up only. Parking is located off-site at the Cocoa Beach High School (less than one mile) will shuttles available.

#### **SECURITY:**

All AAU Junior Olympic Games facilities maintain the right to search any bags, backpacks, purses jackets, etc. throughout the duration of the AAU Junior Olympic Games.

#### FOOD:

All AAU Junior Olympic Games facilities maintain exclusive rights to concessions. Outside food and beverage are not permitted throughout the duration of the AAU Junior Olympic Games. No coolers at any venue.

#### **NO GUARANTEE:**

The AAU cannot and does not guarantee the appearance and/or participation of specific participant(s) and/or teams (as applicable) in this event. The AAU has sanctioned (approved) this Event as an official AAU Event (competition), but the AAU is not and shall not be responsible for any participant's or spectator's expenses related to this Event (nor reimbursements for same) in case of dissatisfaction of any participant, friend, family, or spectator, this includes, but is not limited to all travel, hotel (lodging), food, entry fees and/or any other expenses related to the event.

#### **RESULTS:**

#### **ADMISSION FEE:**

Athletes and coaches with a credential will receive admission to all competition venues and the Celebration of Athletes as part of your entry fee. Please note that you must check-in and pick up your credential prior to receiving admittance into any venue. You must have the appropriate wristband or credential. Due to COVID-19 restrictions the competition area will not allow spectators on deck.

#### **SWIMMERS W/OUT A COACH:**

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a coach, must be approved by their coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

**GENERAL INFO:** Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.

#### **TECH SUITS:**

Swimmers ages ten years and younger shall not compete while wearing "Tech" suits, even when competing in Senior or Open events or time trials.

#### CONDUCT:

Each team is responsible for the behavior of their swimmers. Teams will be financially responsible for any damage caused to the facility by their athletes, coaches, or parents/spectators.

The Referee may remove any swimmer from competition for disruptive or disorderly behavior. The Meet Marshal will notify the Referee and the coach of any swimmer who is behaving/acting in an unsafe manner.

Deck changes are prohibited.

USE OF AUDIO OR VISUAL RECORDING DEVICES, INCLUDING CELL PHONES, IS NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME IN CHANGING AREAS, RESTROOMS, OR LOCKER ROOMS.

#### **INDEMNITY:**

In granting this approval, it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, American Swimming, Blue Wave Swimming, Rocket Swimming and City of Cocoa Beach, shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages by reason of injuries during the conduct of the event.

#### **FIRST AID:**

Supplies will be kept in the first-aid station.

#### **RELAYS:**

A relay will be offered at each session. However, each relay will offer three options (Boys-only, Girls-only, and Mixed). All options will be swum together, but scored separately. Mixed relays at this event means two (2) swimmers of each gender from the same club will compete together (age group restrictions apply). Clubs may enter as many relays as they wish, but a swimmer may only participate in one relay per session. Meet management reserves the right to offer additional non scored relays comprising of two swimmers of each gender from DIFFERENT clubs. That determination will be made when the timeline has been finalized and a motion made at the General Meeting prior to the first session.

#### SEEDING:

Ages and genders will swim together, fastest to slowest, and will be scored separately. The Top eight (8) seeded swimmers for each gender and age will swim together in one heat. This is to ensure the meet runs as fast as possible. Meet management retains the right to change this procedure based on the number of swimmers entered in the meet.

#### RULES:

The AAU has adopted the USA Swimming Technical Rules. Current USAS will govern the event.

#### AWARDS:

AAU Junior Olympic medals 1st - 8th individual events and AAU Junior Olympic ribbons 9th- 16th in individual events, excluding 19+. There will be AAU Banners awarded to the top two Boys Teams and top two Girls Teams for the Long Course, Short Course, and Overall in team points. The Overall Team Awards will be an aggregate of the results from both the long and short course events.

#### SCORING:

Individual events: 17, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 Relays events: 34, 30, 28, 26, 24, 22, 20, 18, 16, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2

#### **AWARD CEREMONIES:**

AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be presented to the top eight (8) finishers in individual events. Club relays we also receive awards. All awards will be presented at the award ceremonies (TBD, based on timeline).

#### WARM-UP:

Safety rules, as outlined by USA Swimming and adopted by the AAU, will be in effect during all warm-up and warm-down time frames and areas. We ask all participating teams to adhere by these guidelines.

#### **SCRATCHES**:

No penalty for scratching.

#### **CHECK IN:**

Distance check in by 8:30am each day an event over 400 meters is offered.

#### **ENTRY LIMIT:**

Swimmers will be limited to three (3) individual events per session plus one relay.

#### TIME TRIALS:

There will be no time trials.

#### **QUALIFICATION:**

This meet is open to all AAU registered swimmers. There are no time standards for the event. However, we ask all coaches to use their discretion in submitting entries. Please consider the preparedness of your athletes when entering events.

#### **AGE DIVISIONS:**

8&U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-18, 19+

#### **DECK ENTRIES:**

No deck entries will be accepted at this event.

#### **ENTRY FEES:**

\$51.00 (for the entire meet at both venues)

#### **ENTRY DEADLINE:**

All entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 14th, 2020. Please register using the link below prior to the deadline:

#### **TEAM REPRESENTATIVE:**

Onsite Long and Short Course- Prior to the start of the meet, the name of one person for each team other than the coach may be given to the meet referee. The meet referee will only recognize the coach and that designated person relative to matters pertaining to the meet.

#### **SPECIAL NOTES:**

Onsite - Events/heats may be combined at the discretion of the meet referee.

Relay entries are due at 4:00 PM on the day before each session to Eva at <a href="eva@fastswimresults.com">eva@fastswimresults.com</a>.

These relays will be deck seeded and swum as outlined in the Order of Events. Relays must consist of four Boys, four Girls, or Mixed; as desired by the submitting Club. Mixed Relay will consist of two (2) boys and two (2) girls. The relays will be swum together, but scored separately. 19 & Over relays are welcomed, but will not score or be awarded. These multiple relay options are intended is to help smaller teams field relays, which are always fun for the swimmers.

NOTE: Relay entries SHOULD NOT be included in original AAU Meet Entry. Only include Individual entries.
