AAU MEMBERSHIP: All participants must be members of their AAU Association and must present their current AAU membership card at athlete

OFFICIAL ENTRY: All entries must be submitted on the "Official" Golf Individual Athlete Entry Form available at www.aaujrogames.org. No

faxes or phone calls will be accepted. A photocopy of the entry form is acceptable.

RULES: Play will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf. The AAU Golf Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions

or schedules herein. The decisions of the AAU Golf Committee in any matter shall be final.

COMPETITION FORMAT: Competition will consist of 54 holes of stroke play. Length of competition may be adjusted at the discretion of the National

Chair due to weather or unforeseen conditions. Competition will be held at Lakes of Taylor on Wednesday, July 30 through

Friday, August 1.

PRACTICE ROUND: Practice round at Lakes of Taylor will be shot gun start at 10:00 am on Tuesday, July 29. First round competition tee times

will be assigned on the day of the practice round. Cost of practice round on Tuesday, July 29 is included in entry fee. Any other practice times on other days must be scheduled through Lakes of Taylor at www.taylorgolf.com or 734-784-4653.

Cost of additional practice rounds is the responsibility of the participant. Costs are available on the web site.

Lakes of Taylor allows soft spikes (non-metal) only on the course. Complimentary driving range balls are also included.

RULES MEETING: Tuesday, July 29, 9:00 a.m. at Lakes of Taylor. This is a mandatory participant rules meeting. Parents are welcome!

AWARDS:

AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be awarded to athletes who place in the top six (6) in each age flight for boys and girls. The overall boys and girls medallist will receive an AAU watch. Separate awards will be presented to the Long Drive Champions for both boys and girls.

CHECK-IN:

Pre-Registration: It is extremely important that all entries be received no later than the above-mentioned deadline date. Entries will be accepted after the deadline as approved by the National Chair. Of course, we want as many athletes as possible to participate, so please get all entry forms in on time.

On-Site Check-In: Check-In for athletes, coaches, clubs and teams participating in the AAU Junior Olympic Games will be held at Ford Field located in downtown Detroit at 2000 Brush Street. Please follow posted signs to the Check-In Area. Parking fees will typically range from \$3.00-\$6.00 per day, but other area events can cause parking fees to fluctuate. CELEBRATION OF ATHLETES:

The 2003 AAU Junior Olympic Games *Celebration of Athletes* will be held at Ford Field located in downtown Detroit on Monday, July 28 at 7:00 p.m. All athletes are encouraged to attend, as you won't want to miss the 2003 Celebration. The format of this year's Celebration has changed dramatically. Take some time to meet your fellow athletes from other states. Check the web site at www.aaujrogames.org for more announcements on this year's *Celebration of Athletes*. Parking fees will typically range from \$3.00-\$6.00 per day, but other area events downtown can cause parking fees to fluctuate.

HOUSING:

All requests for hotels will be handled by the Detroit Housing Bureau. **Contact the Housing Bureau toll free at 877-228-9389 or book your rooms on-line at www.aaujrogames.org.** For a complete listing of properties please see the housing section of the Handbook or the web site. You will need to have the following information ready when contacting the Housing Bureau:

- 2. The number of people in your party
- 3. The number of rooms you need
- 4. Your arrival and departure dates
- 5. Your credit card number

IMPORTANT: All reservations require a one-night room and tax deposit through an approved form of credit. In the event an attendee needs to cancel their reservation, the cancellation must occur prior to 72 hours from the confirmed arrival date. If the cancellation occurs within 72 hours of the scheduled arrival, the hotel reserves the right to charge the guest for one night's room and tax.

PARKING:

The majority of venues for the 2003 AAU Junior Olympic Games will offer complimentary parking. However, exceptions to this include Ford Field in Downtown Detroit and Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti. Parking fees will typically range from \$3.00-\$6.00 per day, but other area events can cause parking fees to fluctuate. Parking regulations are strictly enforced both in Downtown Detroit and on-campus at Eastern Michigan University. Please obey all posted parking regulations, as the cost of a parking ticket will outweigh the cost of parking. More details on parking can be found in the *Athletes'*, *Coaches'*, *and Parents' Handbook*.

Also, please note that most downtown hotels will charge for parking at their location. These prices vary and often can be added directly to your hotel bill upon checkout. Please contact your hotel directly to determine if you will be charged for parking.

TRANSPORTATION:

All athletes, coaches, and fans are responsible for their own transportation to and from all activities, events, and hotels.

SECURITY:

All 2003 AAU Junior Olympic Games facilities maintain the right to search any bags, backpacks, purses, jackets, etc. throughout the duration of the 2003 AAU Junior Olympic Games.

FOOD:

All 2003 AAU Junior Olympic Games facilities maintain exclusive rights to concessions. Outside food and beverage are not permitted throughout the duration of the 2003 AAU Junior Olympic Games.

ADMISSION FEE:

Each sport is a part of the 2003 AAU Junior Olympic Games. Admission to all venues and the Celebration of Athletes for credentialed participants only is included in your entry fee. Please note that you must check-in and pick up your athlete or coach credential prior to receiving admittance into any venue, including the Celebration of Athletes. All other spectators will be able to enjoy any of the sporting events and ceremonies throughout the 2003 AAU Junior Olympic Games by purchasing an admission ticket that is valid for all the sports involved in the Games.
