Primary thru Midget are restricted to 3 events, including relays. Sub-Youth thru Young Men/Women are restricted to 4 events, including relays. **All entry fees are to be paid online with a credit card. At the end of the process you can print out the confirmation page(s) and then send a copy of the page showing the amount you paid along with a waiver which may be downloaded from www.eteamz.active.com/mtaa for each athlete.** Athletes need to have proof of age (i.e. copy of birth certificate). **THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS OR TRANSFERS. NO FAX ENTRIES ACCEPTED.** Submit relays online. But, also list relay on individual entry (even if athlete is an alternate – it will count towards entry limit).

PACKET PICK UP: 8:00 a.m. (May 23, 2009)

MISC.: Competitors must supply own implements. **¼ inch spikes will be aggressively enforced.**

AWARDS: There will be medal awards for the 1st thru 3rd place. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th thru 6th place for individual events. Relays will be awarded medals for 1st thru 3rd place only.

Directions to Track Stadium:

Take Interstate 85 south of Atlanta to Exit #61 (Fairburn/Peachtree City/Ga. Hwy. 74). Turn right off ramp. Travel about 1/3 mile and you will see a road fork to the right. Take the road that forks to the right (Senoia Rd). Go to 2nd stop sign. Turn right on East Broad Street (in front of railroad tracks), drive one block, and turn right on Malone Road. Visitor parking is available in the parking lot on your left.
From south: Take 85 N to Exit 61. Turn left off of the exit and follow above directions.

From I 20: Take I 20 E to exit 37 (Hwy 92). Follow 92 E (or S) to Fairburn. When you come to intersection 92/29 (Main Street), stay straight on 92 and pass under a railroad bridge. Turn right at light onto Broad Street. School is on left. To find visitor parking, turn left on Malone Road and look for spots marked "visitor" in the parking lot on your left.
