#### **DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES AND FEES:**

1. The fee per athlete is as follows:

Multi-Event \$15.00

- 2. **Multi-Event Competition:** All entries and fees must be <u>received by</u> Friday, May 30, 2008. The fee for participation is \$15.00 per athlete
- 3. Late Fees: A late fee of \$5.00 per entry will be assessed for any entry <u>received after</u> the deadline. The host team has the right to refuse the entry of any athlete that is received after the deadline.

<u>AAU Membership:</u> All athletes and coaches must be members of the PVAAU District in order to participate in the district meet and must be able to present their AAU card at the time of check-in. For additional membership information contact: Johnnie Mae Armstrong 301-460-1569 or register on-line at <a href="https://www.aausports.org">www.aausports.org</a>.

**PROOF OF AGE:** Proof of age is required and must be available for review during the competition. Acceptable documents include: birth certificates, US passport, US Government documents, certified baptismal record, Indian tribal enrollment certificate, Bureau of Indian Affairs, or state drivers' license. Athletes competing in an incorrect age group **will be disqualified from the competition**.

**STICKERS:** All competitors are responsible for having stickers for each event. The sticker must contain the following information: name; club status; birthyear; event; sex.

<u>AWARDS</u>: Awards and information packets will be available for pick up when event results are announced and posted. AAU Championship Medals will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>,

- 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers and ribbons for 4<sup>th-</sup>6<sup>th</sup> place finishers in each event.

<u>ADVANCEMENT:</u> The top **8 (eight)** in each event advance to the AAU Region 2B Championship Meet, in Upper Marlboro, MD on July 10 – 13, 2008.

**VOLUNTEERS**: Are welcome.

**PROTEST PROCEDURES:** The meet director must be notified in writing within 30 minutes of the perceived infraction. A fifty (\$50.00) dollar **non-refundable** fee is required at the time of the protest. The decision of the jury of appeals is final.

**FACILITIES:** Six lane track, runways and aprons require 1/4" spikes or less

<u>CLEAN-UP:</u> Trash bags will be provided. Please keep your area clean. Coaches who fail to ensure that their respective team areas are appropriately maintained and cleaned may be precluded for further participation in the meet.

**EQUIPMENT:** Each team/athlete must supply their own field event implements and starting blocks. It may be necessary to select a field implement as the Official Implement to be used by all of the competitors. Blocks are only permitted in the finals of the 100m.

<u>ADDITIONAL NOTES (General)</u>: Sections, heats, flights may be combined at the discretion of the meet director or field events judges.

ONLY MEET OFFICIALS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD, TRACK, OR IN THE CLERKING AREA. ONLY ATHLETES WHOSE EVENT HAS BEEN CALLED ARE ALLOWED ON THE TRACK, FIELD OR IN THE CLERKING AREA. ATHLETES MUST REPORT TO THE CLERKING AREA DRESSED FOR COMPETITION.

Competitors must attempt every event of their multi-event competition.

Order of events may be changed at the discretion of the meet director. However, event start times will not be changed without advance notice.
