#### **DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES AND FEES:**

- 1. The fees per athlete are as follows:
  - a. Track and Field \$15.00

2. **Track and Field Competition**: All entries and fees must be <u>received by</u> Wednesday, June 11, 2008.

3. A late registration fee of \$5.00 will be assessed to any late entries accepted by the Meet Director. Acceptance of late entries is within the sole discretion of the meet director. NO TEAM WALKUPS WILL BE ACCEPTED, NO EXCEPTIONS.

4. All entry fees may be sent to the address listed below and must be in the form of either a cashier's check or money order made payable to the:

<u>AAU Membership:</u> All athletes and coaches must be members of the PVAAU District in order to participate in the district meet and must be able to present their AAU card at the time of check-in. For additional membership information contact: Johnnie Mae Armstrong 301-460-1569 or register on-line at <u>www.aausports.org</u>.

**PROOF OF AGE:** Proof of age is required and must be available for review during the competition. Acceptable documents include: birth certificates, US passport, US Government documents, certified baptismal record, Indian tribal enrollment certificate, Bureau of Indian Affairs, or state drivers' license. Athletes competing in an incorrect age group **will be disqualified from that event**. Intentional or repeated participation in an incorrect age group may result in disqualification from the entire competition. It is the coaches' ultimate responsibility to ensure participation in the correct age group.

**STICKERS:** All competitors are responsible for having stickers for each event they participate in. The sticker must contain the following information: name, club status, birth year, event, sex.

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**<u>AWARDS</u>**: Awards and information packets will be available for pick up when event results are announced and posted. AAU Championship Medals will be awarded to  $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$  place finishers and ribbons for  $4^{th}-8^{th}$  place finishers in each event.

**ADVANCEMENT:** The top 8 in each event advance to the AAU Region II Championship Meet, in Upper Marlboro, MD July 10-13, 2008.

**VOLUNTEERS:** Are welcome.

**PROTEST PROCEDURES:** The meet director must be notified in writing within 30 minutes of the perceived infraction. A fifty (\$50.00) dollar **non-refundable** fee is required at the time of the protest. The decision of the jury of appeals is final.

**FACILITIES:** Eight? lane track, runways, and aprons require <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" spikes or less.

**<u>CLEAN-UP:</u>** Trash bags will be provided. Please keep your area clean. Coaches who fail to ensure that their respective team areas are appropriately maintained and cleaned may be precluded for further participation in the meet.

**EQUIPMENT:** Each team/athlete must supply their own field event implements, starting blocks, and batons. However, it may be necessary to select a field implement as the Official Implement to be used by all of the competitors. Blocks are only permitted in the finals of the 100m.

**ADDITIONAL NOTES (General):** Sections, heats, flights may be combined at the discretion of the meet director or field event judges.

ONLY MEET OFFICIALS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD, TRACK, OR IN THE CLERKING AREA. ONLY ATHLETES WHOSE EVENT HAS BEEN CALLED ARE ALLOWED ON THE TRACK, FIELD OR IN THE CLERKING AREA. ATHLETES MUST REPORT TO THE CLERKING AREA DRESSED FOR COMPETITION.

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#### **ORDER OF EVENTS**:

Note: Athletes must be available to check-in 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the event. Athletes should proceed to check-in on the first call. Once the final call is made for an event, the athlete will have 5 remaining minutes to check-in. <u>Late check-ins will not be permitted.</u> The meet will proceed on a rolling schedule.
