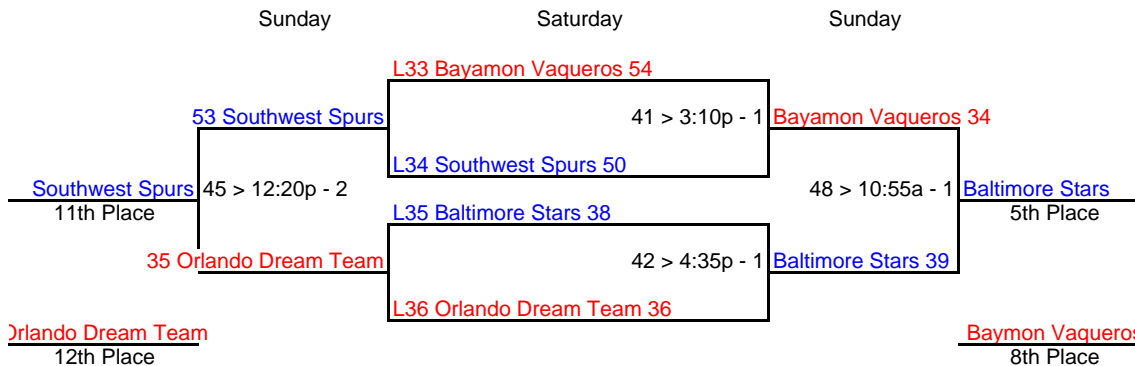
## 1st Round Losers



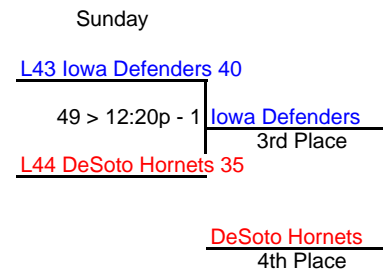
