Jackie was on the choreography team for the Opening and Closing Ceremonies of the 2002 Winter Olympics in Salt Lake City. She has also choreographed various nationally famed events and ceremonies during her career, such as ceremonies for the US Olympic gymnastics finals and the awarding British Airways commercial.

Jackie performs professionally in theatre on the stage and screen. She has appeared in the Television series, Cover Me, Touched by an Angel, and Everwood, as well as commercials and videos. She had the featured role in the movie "A Good Run", and supporting roles in "Charly", and "Heber Holiday".

As a former Miss Utah for Miss America, Jackie volunteers her time to train young ladies for numerous scholarship pageants and dance competitions. She was the traveling companion to Miss Utah for the Miss America pageant.

Jackie is the co founder of all forms of Dance and Drill Teams as a sport in the Amateur Athletic Union, which also participates in the AAU Junior Olympic Games. She is the Amateur Athletic Union Dance-Dance/Drill National Chairperson.
